DVSS JULY 2020 (VITAL STATISTICS RIZAL INDICATORS)

Date of Release: September 15, 2020

This report summarizes the data gathered from July 2020 documents submitted from the local civil registry offices of the thirteen municipalities and a city in the province of Rizal. The number of vital events in Rizal for reached 6,128 registered documents.

This represents 10.70% decrease from the 6,862 registered vital events from the previous month. The province generated the following statistics: four thousand three hundred seventy-three (4,373) for birth, three hundred eleven (311) for marriage and one thousand four hundred forty-four (1,444) for death.

Civil registration is a continuous, permanent, and compulsory recording of vital events occurring in the life of an individual such as birth, marriage, and death as well as court decrees, and legal instruments affecting his civil status in appropriate registers as mandated by Act No. 3753, the Civil Registry Law.

In this July 2020 issue, the Philippine Statistics Authority of Rizal presents the number of births, marriages, and deaths registered by municipalities in the province. The data are preliminary result from the Decentralized Vital Statistics System 2011 based on the documents submitted (Timely and Late Registered) by the Local Civil Registry Offices in Rizal.

BIRTH STATISTICS

- Province of Rizal recorded 3,225 timely registered births for the month of July 2020. City of Antipolo has the highest contribution of live births with 983, followed by San Mateo with 445 and Taytay with 438. Municipality of Jala-jala has the least contribution with 9 live births (see *Table B*).
- There were 104 newborn babies daily in the province for the month of July 2020.
- The timely data recorded presented 51.38 percent for the males and 48.62 percent for the females. It means that male born babies was higher by 5.68 percent than the female born babies for this month.
- About 2,336 births (72.43%) were attended by physicians followed by midwives, 775 (24.03%), while 113 (3.50%) were attended by hilot. (see *Table C*).
- 34.98 percent or 1,128 of the mothers in the province had their first-born baby for the month of July 2020.

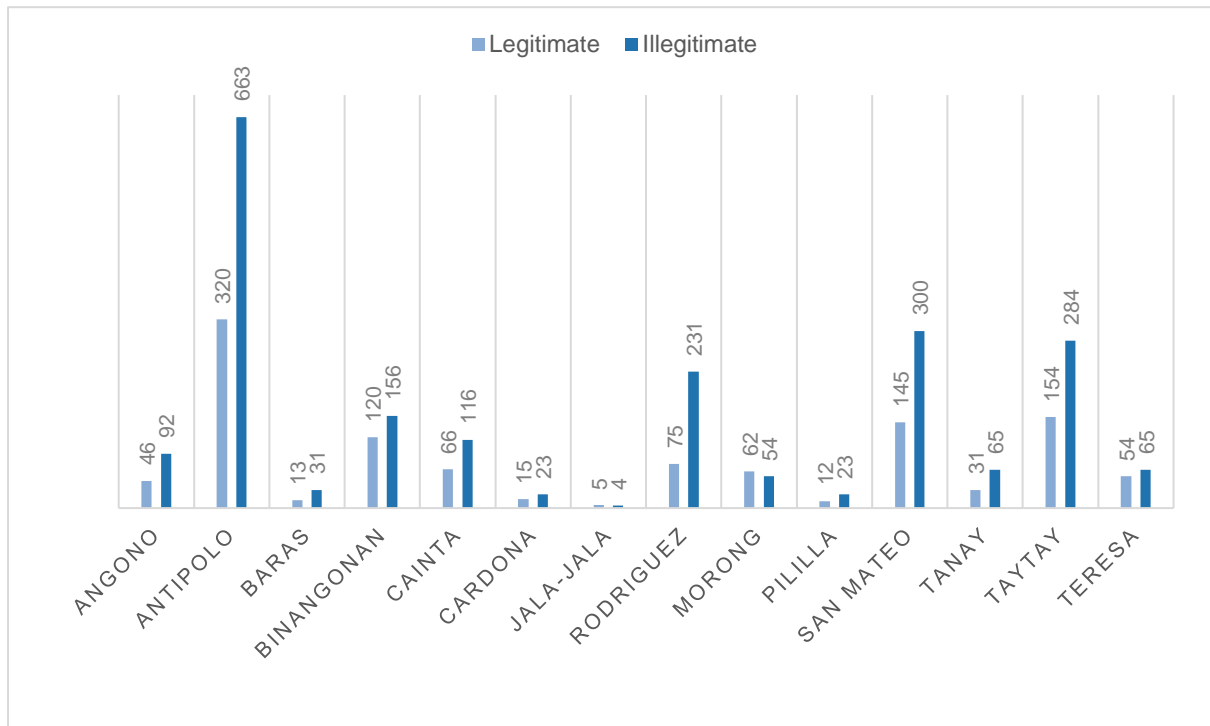

Out of fourteen city/municipalities, Baras and Pililla had no recorded birth attended by physicians. While Jalajala, had 5 recorded birth that were attended by a physician.

More than thirty percent (1,118 or 34.67%) of babies born in Rizal were legitimate. Municipality of Jalajala posted the highest legitimacy percentage with 5 or 55.56 percent of the total born children in the municipality level while Municipality of Rodriguez showed the highest illegitimacy percentage with 231 or 75.49 percent of the born children this month (see Figure II).

Modal age group for mothers was at 25 to 29 with 985 occurrences (30.54%). Teenage mothers (19 years old and below) listed two hundred forty two (242) births or 7.50 percent, while the non-fertile age group (45 years old and over) showed fertility performance at eight (8) recorded live births or 0.25 percent.

- As the table shows, month of July has 280 timely registered marriages compare to 265 of the previous month (*refer to Table E*). It was 5.66 percent increased of registration.

- The city/municipality that has the highest number of timely marriages recorded in Antipolo City with 53 registered documents, followed by Taytay with 40; Angono and Cainta, with 32 marriages.

- The City of Antipolo has the highest number of Catholic marriages in the province with twenty five (25) instances, eleven (11) on the civil ceremonies and seventeen (17) on other religious rites.

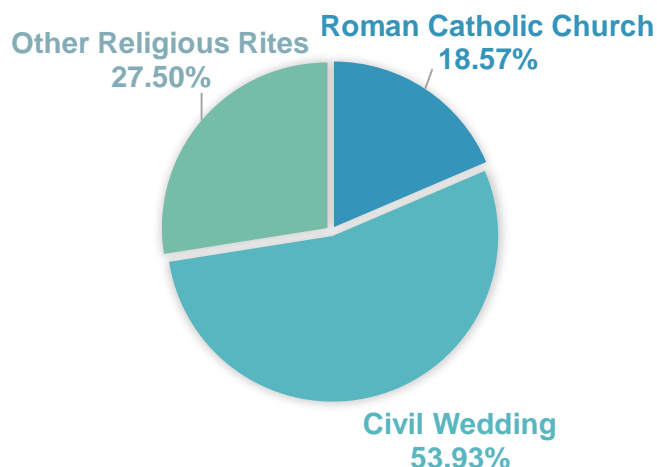
- There are five (5) recorded widows and none divorced / separated on bride's civil status. While three (3) widowers and one (1) divorced/separated recorded on the grooms.

- Province-wide, civil ceremonies initiated by the local chief executives in coordination with the municipal civil registrars including those solemnized by judges got the highest number of registrations with 151 (53.93%).
- Ceremonies officiated by other religious sect. recorded 77 events or 27.50 percent.
- Roman Catholic ceremonies recorded 52 events or 18.57 percent.

Teen brides have three (3) or 1.07% recorded marriages while teen grooms had no recorded event this month. There was one (1) recorded groom that aged above 75 years old that undergo marriage (See Table F).

Registered death records on children under one-year old increased by 10 deaths compared to the previous month.

DEATH STATISTICS

The province also generated 1,406 timely registered deaths for the month of July. Antipolo City was on the top with three hundred ninety-two (392) deaths, followed by Rodriguez with one hundred fifty-seven (157) deaths and Binangonan with one hundred fifty-five (155). Municipality of Jalajala has the least number of deaths with ten (10) records.

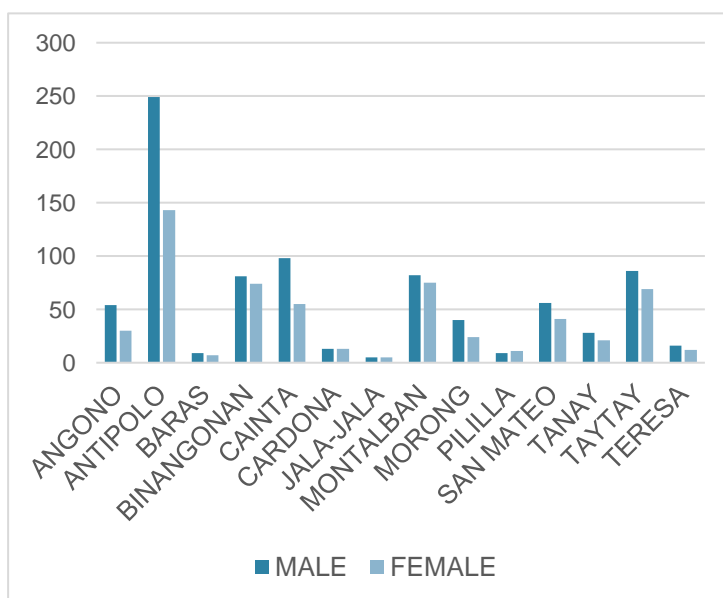
Records showed that there were 58 timely infant deaths in total. City of Antipolo recorded eighteen (18). Meanwhile Baras, Cardona, Pililla and Teresa have no registered documents on infant deaths.

The modal age group for the number of timely registered deaths was at 65-69 years old with 178 occurrences in July 2020.

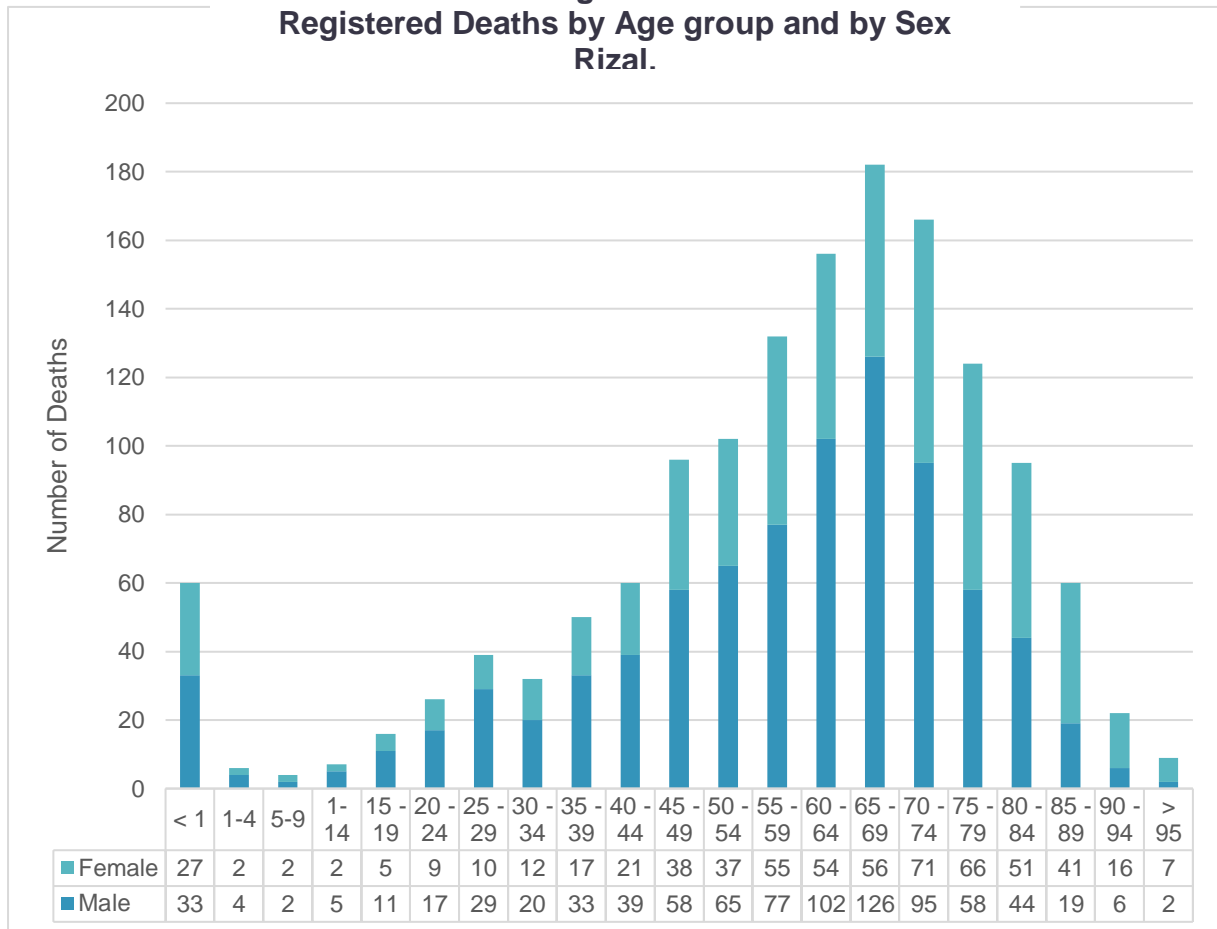
Figure IV. Timely Registered Deaths by Sex and by Municipality



- 913 or 64.94 percent of the registered deaths in the province died in their homes, whereas about 489 or 34.78 percent died at hospitals.
- 50.85 percent been medically attended by the physicians, public health officer and in hospital before they died.

- Based on the graph, highest number of deaths for male was on ages 65-69 years old, while for female, the highest number of deaths was on the ages 70-74 years old (see Figure V.)
- For the month of July 2020, based on the graph, male has the highest number of registered deaths compared to the number of deaths of the female.
- In terms of the civil status of the death, 28.24% of them were single, 52.92% were married and 18.56% were widow/widower.
- In regards to corpse disposal, 71.88 percent of death went through interment while 28.05 percent were cremated.
