### DVSS JUNE 2020 (VITAL STATISTICS RIZAL INDICATORS)

**Date of Release:** August 14, 2020

**Reference No.:** 2020-024

This report summarizes the data gathered from June 2020 documents submitted from the local civil registry offices of the thirteen municipalities and a city in the province of Rizal. The number of vital events in Rizal for reached 6,862 registered documents.

This represents 55.21% increase from the 4,421 registered vital events from the previous month. The province generated the following statistics: 5,115 for birth, 348 for marriage and 1,399 for death.

Civil registration is a continuous, permanent, and compulsory recording of vital events occurring in the life of an individual such as birth, marriage, and death as well as court decrees, and legal instruments affecting his civil status in appropriate registers as mandated by Act No. 3753, the Civil Registry Law.

In this June 2020 issue, the Philippine Statistics Authority of Rizal presents the number of births, marriages, and deaths registered by municipalities in the province. The data are preliminary result from the Decentralized Vital Statistics System 2011 based on the documents submitted (Timely and Late Registered) by the Local Civil Registry Offices in Rizal.

## BIRTH STATISTICS

- Province of Rizal recorded 3,260 timely registered births for the month of June 2020. City of Antipolo has the highest contribution of live births with 987, followed by San Mateo with 488 and Taytay with 441. Municipality of Jala-jala has the least contribution with 14 live births (see Table B).
- There were 108 newborn babies daily in the province for the month of June 2020.
- The timely data recorded presented 52.39 percent for the males and 47.61 percent for the females. It means that male born babies was higher by 10.05 percent than the female born babies for this month.
- About 2,133 births (65.43%) were attended by physicians followed by midwives, 955 (29.29%), while 169 (5.18%) were attended by hilot. (see Table C).
- 33.93 percent or 1,106 of the mothers in the province had their first-born baby for the month of June 2020.

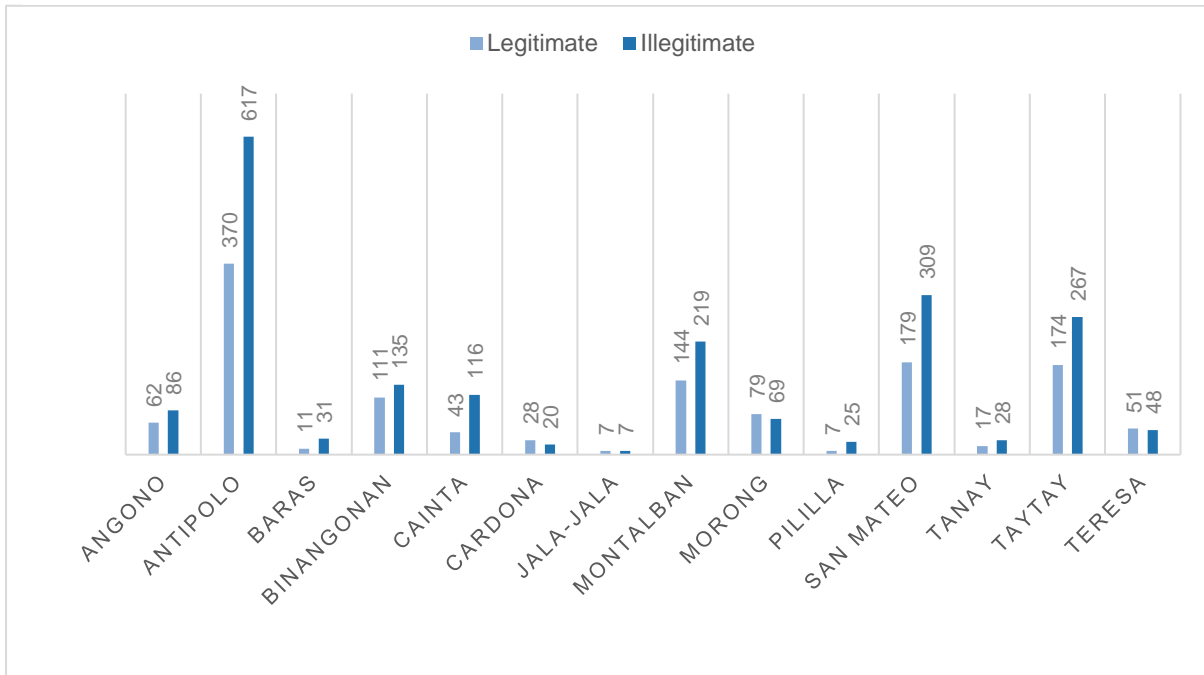

Out of fourteen city/municipalities, Baras and Pililla had no recorded birth attended by physicians. While Tanay, had 4 recorded birth that were attended by a physician.

More than thirty percent (1,283 or 39.36%) of babies born in Rizal were legitimate. Municipality of Cardona posted the highest legitimacy percentage with 28 or 58.33 percent of the total born children in the municipality level while Municipality of Pililla showed the highest illegitimacy percentage with 25 or 78.13 percent of the born children this month (see Figure II).

Modal age group for mothers was at 25 to 29 with 977 occurrences (29.97%). Teenage mothers (19 and below) listed 211 births or 6.47 percent, while the non-fertile age group (45 and over) showed fertility performance at eleven (11) recorded live births or 0.34 percent.

- As the table shows, month of June has 265 timely registered marriages compare to 12 of the previous month (*refer to Table E*). It is an extreme increase of registration due to the implementation of General Community Quarantine (GCQ) in the province that allows gatherings with at least 10 guests or participants.

- The city/municipality that has the highest number of timely marriages recorded in Antipolo City with 72 registered documents, followed by Cainta with 60; Taytay, with 25 marriages.

- The City of Antipolo has the highest number of Catholic marriages in the province with 37 instances, and 16 on the civil ceremonies.

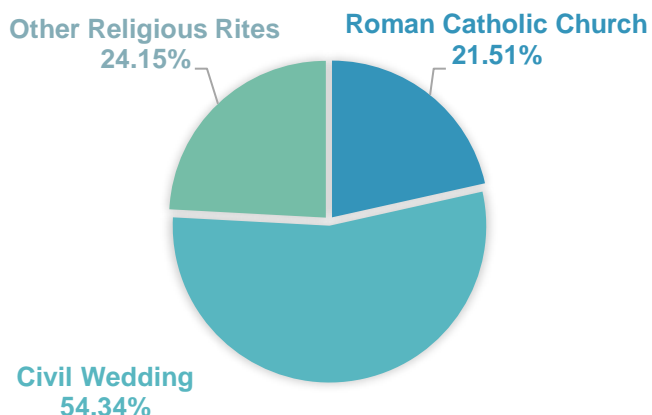
- There are no recorded widows and divorced / separated on bride’s civil status. While two (2) widowers and one (1) divorced/ separated recorded on the grooms.

- Province-wide, civil ceremonies initiated by the local chief executives in coordination with the municipal civil registrars including those solemnized by judges got the highest number of registrations with 144 (54.34%).
- Roman Catholic ceremonies recorded 57 event or 21.51 percent.

Teen brides have one (1) or 0.38 % recorded marriages while teen grooms had no recorded event this month. There was one (1) recorded groom that aged above 75 years old that undergo marriage (See Table F).

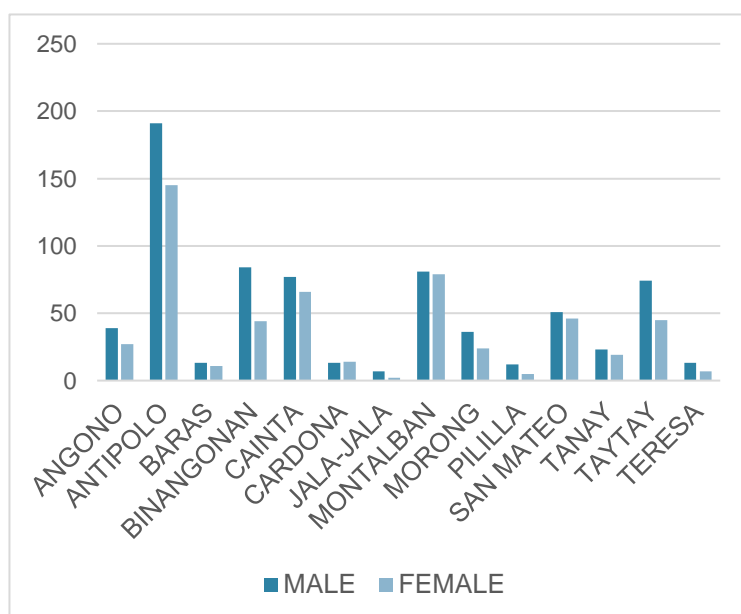
The province also generated 1,248 timely registered deaths for the month of June. Antipolo City was on the top with 336 deaths, followed by Rodriguez with 160 deaths and Cainta with 143. Municipality of Jala-jala have the least number of deaths with 9 records.

Records showed that there were 41 timely infant deaths in total. City of Antipolo recorded eight (8). Meanwhile Jalajala, Pililla, Tanay and Teresa have no registered documents on infant deaths.

The modal age for the number of timely registered deaths was at 60-64 years old with 147 occurrences in June 2020.

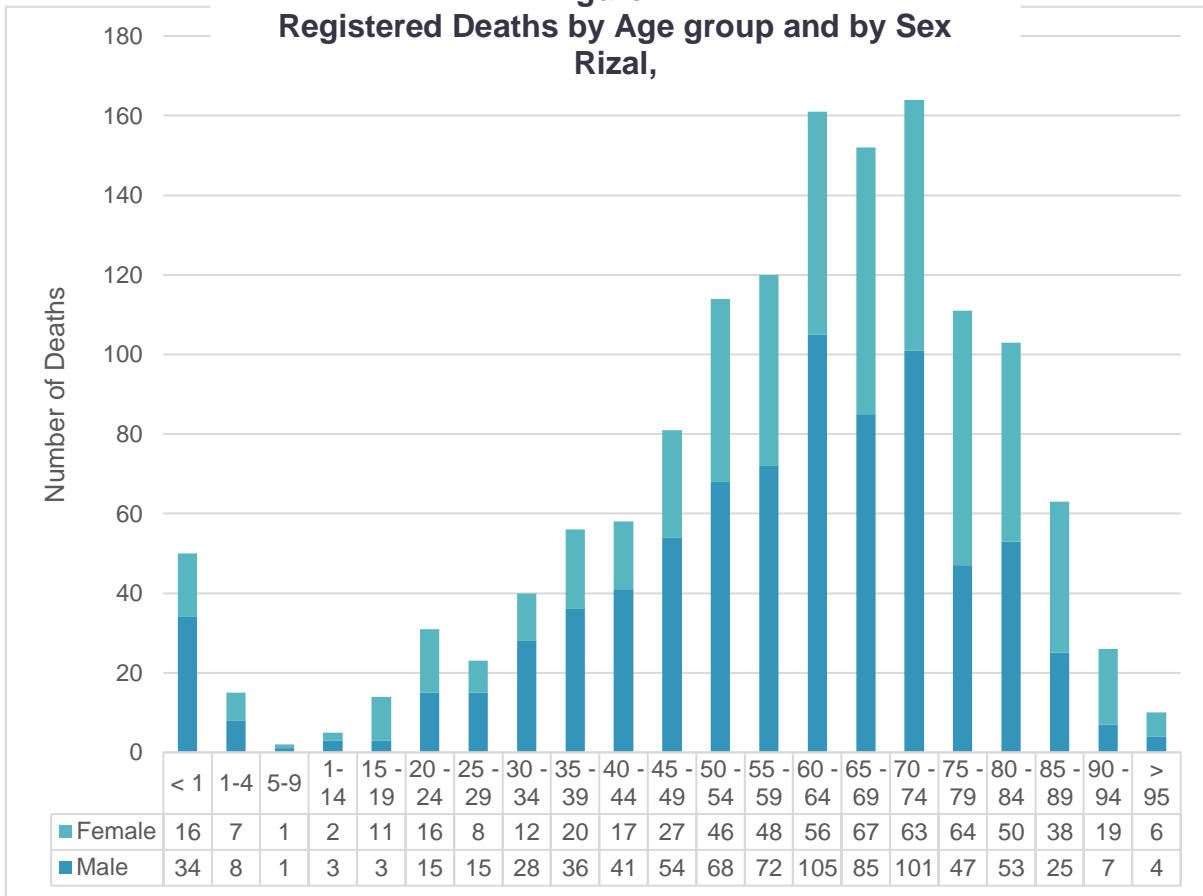
- 805 or 64.50 percent of the registered deaths in the province died in their homes, whereas about 440 or 35.26 percent died at hospitals.
- 62.74 percent been medically attended by the physicians, public health officer and in hospital before they died.

- Based on the graph, highest number of deaths for male was on the ages 60-64 years old, while for female, the highest number of deaths was on the ages 65-69 years old (see Figure V.)
- For the month of June 2020, based on the graph, male has the highest number of registered deaths compared to the number of deaths of the female.
- In terms of the civil status of the death, 30.00% of them were single, 47.87% were married and 21.94% were widow/widower.
- In regards to corpse disposal, 72.27 percent of death went through interment while 27.52 percent were cremated, an increase of 225 cremated deaths from the previous month.
