## DVSS NOVEMBER 2020 (VITAL STATISTICS RIZAL INDICATORS)

Date of Release: January 18, 2021

Reference No.: 2021-001

This report summarizes the data gathered from November 2020 documents submitted from the local civil registry offices of the thirteen municipalities and a city in the province of Rizal. The number of vital events in Rizal for reached 6,590 registered documents.

This represents 9.49% decreased from the 7,281 registered vital events from the previous month. The province generated the following statistics: four thousand eight hundred sixty-seven (4,867) for birth, four hundred ten (410) for marriage and one thousand three hundred thirteen (1,313) for death.

Civil registration is a continuous, permanent, and compulsory recording of vital events occurring in the life of an individual such as birth, marriage, and death as well as court decrees, and legal instruments affecting his civil status in appropriate registers as mandated by Act No. 3753, the Civil Registry Law.

In this November 2020 issue, the Philippine Statistics Authority of Rizal presents the number of births, marriages, and deaths registered by municipalities in the province. The data are preliminary result from the Decentralized Vital Statistics System 2011 based on the documents submitted (Timely and Late Registered) by the Local Civil Registry Offices in Rizal.

## BIRTH STATISTICS

- Province of Rizal recorded 3,707 timely registered births for the month of November 2020. City of Antipolo has the highest contribution of live births with 1,194 followed by Taytay with 510 and Rodriguez with 428. Municipality of Jala-jala has the least contribution with 9 live births (see Table B).
- There were 123 newborn babies daily in the province for the month of November 2020.
- The timely data recorded presented 52.25 percent for the males and 47.75 percent for the females. It means that male born babies was higher by 9.44 percent than the female born babies for this month.
- About 2,255 births (60.83%) were attended by physicians followed by midwives, 1,212 (32.69%), while 236 (6.37%) were attended by hilot. (see Table C).
- 34.29 percent or 1,271 of the mothers in the province had their first-born baby for the month of November 2020.

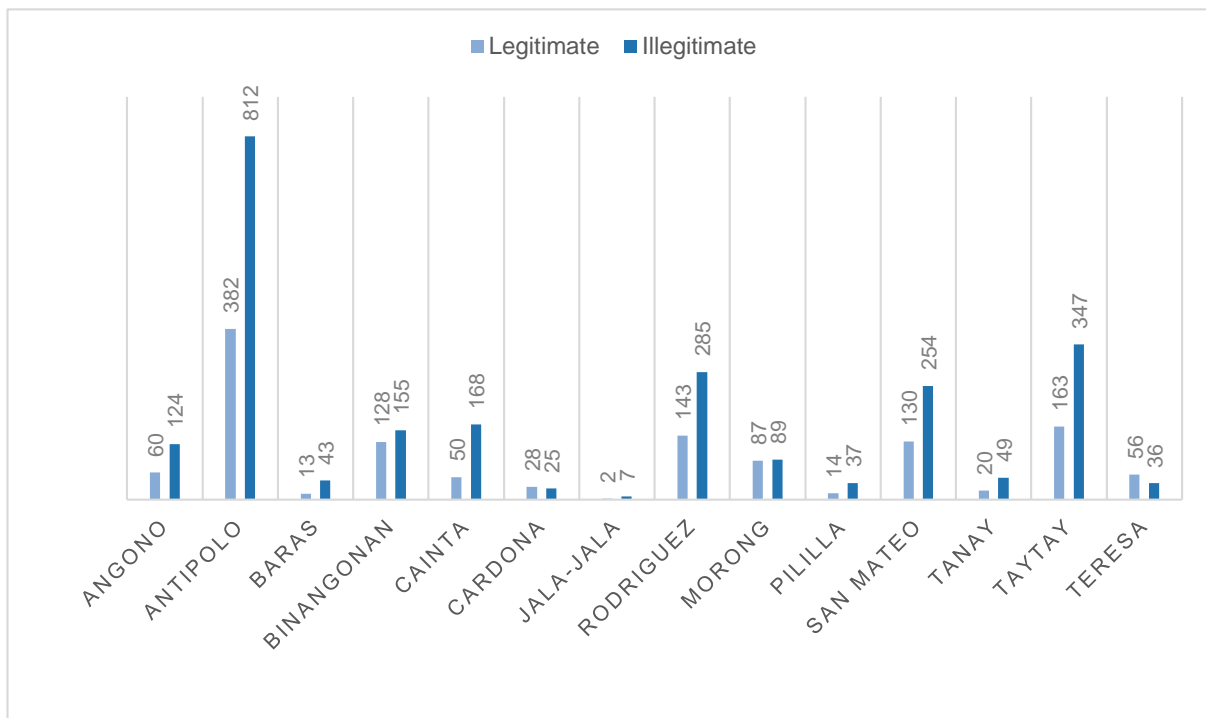

Out of fourteen city/municipalities, Baras and Pililla had no recorded birth attended by physicians, while Tanay and Jalajala had the least number of birth attended by physician with three and five respectively.

More than thirty percent (1,276 or 34.42%) of babies born in Rizal were legitimate. Municipality of Teresa posted the highest legitimacy percentage with 56 or 60.87 percent of the total born children in the municipality level while Municipality of Jalajala showed the highest illegitimacy percentage with 7 or 77.78 percent of the born children this month (see *Figure II*).

Modal age group for mothers was at 25 to 29 with 1,069 occurrences (28.84%). Teenage mothers (19 years old and below) listed two hundred eighty (280) births or 7.55 percent, while the non-fertile age group (45 years old and over) showed fertility performance at three (3) recorded live births or 0.08 percent.

- As the table shows, month of November has 391 timely registered marriages compare to 557 of the previous month (*refer to Table E*). It was 29.80 percent decreased of registration.

- The city/municipality that has the highest number of timely marriages recorded in Antipolo City with 170 registered documents, followed by Cainta with 47 and Taytay with 37 marriages.

- The City of Antipolo has the highest number of Catholic marriages in the province with seventy-seven (77) instances, sixty (60) on the civil ceremonies and thirty-three (33) on other religious rites.

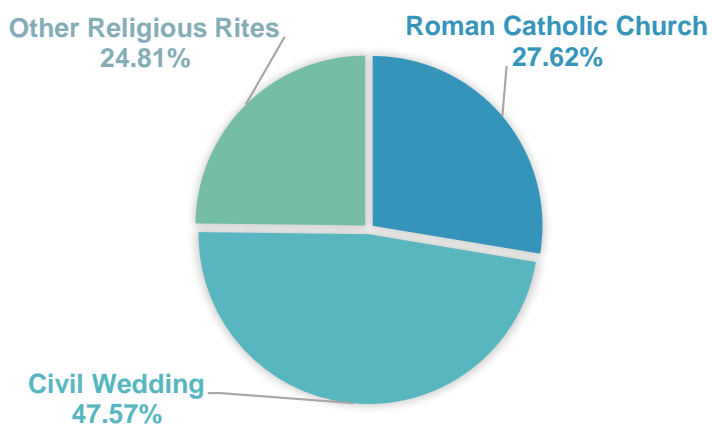
- There are three (3) recorded widows on bride's civil status and six (6) widowers on the grooms. No recorded divorced / separated on bride while one (1) on groom's civil status.

- Province-wide, civil ceremonies initiated by the local chief executives in coordination with the municipal civil registrars including those solemnized by judges got the highest number of registrations with 186 (47.57%).

- Roman Catholic ceremonies recorded 108 events or 27.62 percent.

- Ceremonies officiated by other religious sect. recorded 97 events or 24.81 percent.

# SPECIAL RELEASE

Teen brides had five (5) or 1.28% recorded marriages while teen grooms had two (2) or 0.51% recorded event this month. There were two (2) recorded grooms that aged 70 years old and over that undergo marriage. The modal age group for groom and bride was 25- 29 years old with 158 and 174 occurrences respectively. # SPECIAL RELEASE

Registered death records on children under one-year old decreased by 29 deaths compared to the previous month.

## DEATH STATISTICS

The province also generated 1,288 timely registered deaths for the month of November. Antipolo City was on the top with three hundred forty-four (344) deaths, followed by Binangonan with one hundred seventy (170) deaths and Rodriguez with one hundred fifty-three (153). Municipality of Jalajala has the least number of deaths with eleven (11) records.

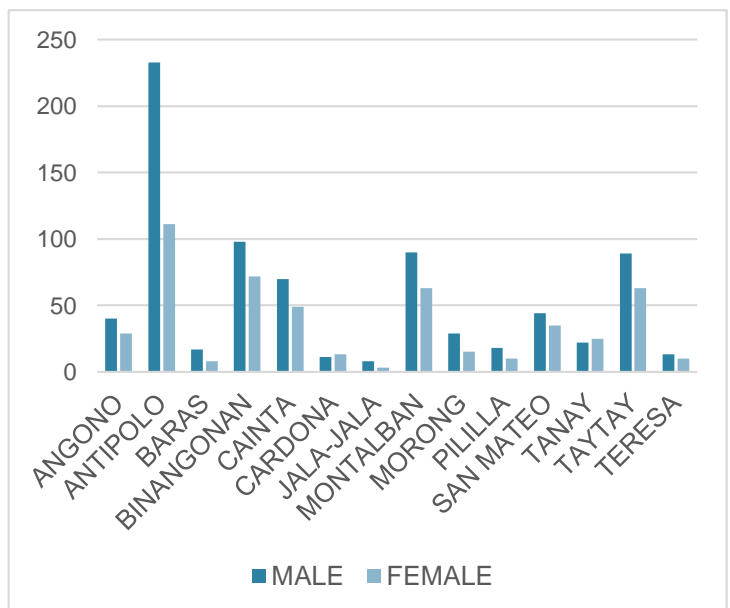

Records showed that there were 27 timely infant deaths in total. Binangonan recorded seven (7) infant deaths. Meanwhile Baras, Jalajala, Pililla, Tanay and Teresa had no registered documents on infant deaths.

The modal age group for the number of timely registered deaths was at 65-69 years old with 149 occurrences in November 2020.

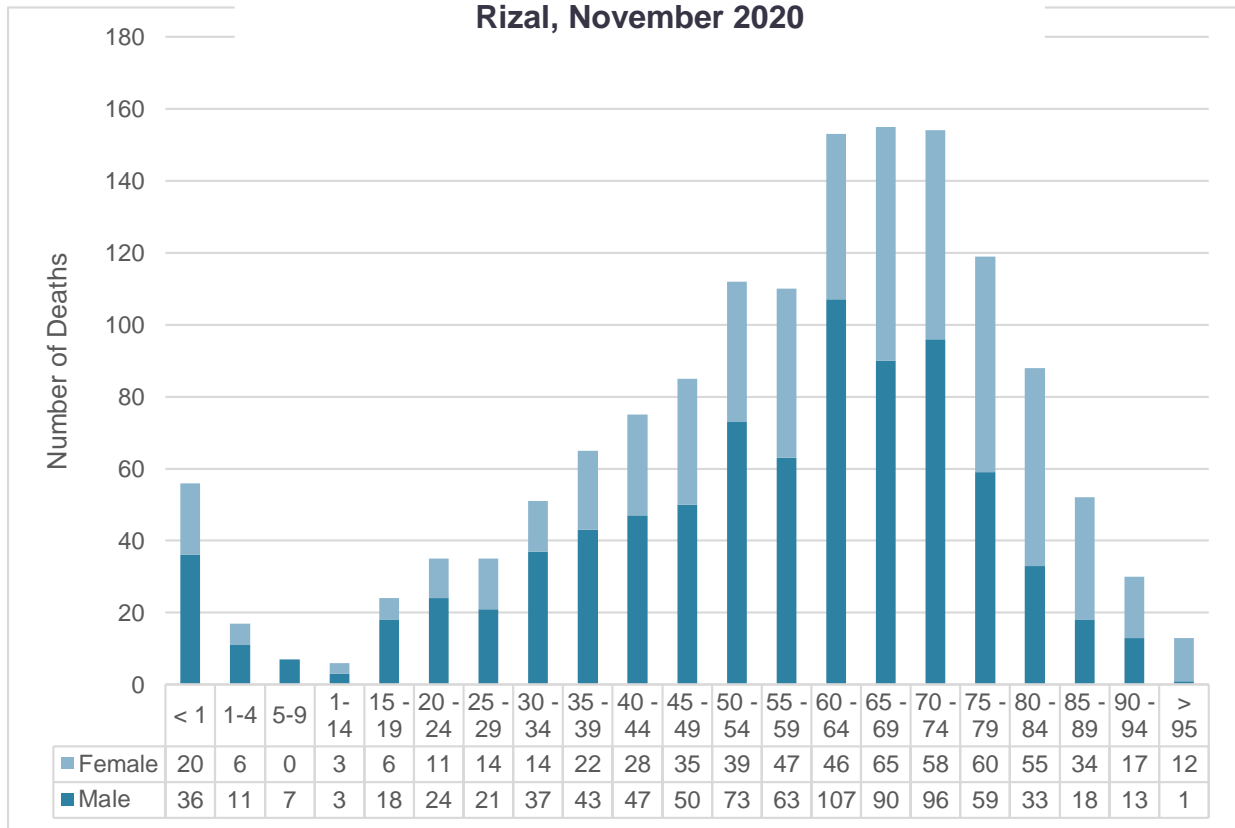
**Figure IV. Timely Registered Deaths by Sex and by Municipality**



- 830 or 64.44 percent of the registered deaths in the province died in their homes, whereas about 454 or 35.25 percent died at hospitals.
- 39.83 percent has been medically attended by the physicians, public health officer and in hospital before they pass away.

- Based on the graph, highest number of deaths for male was on ages 60-64 years old, while for female, the highest number of deaths was on ages 65-69 years old (see Figure V.)
- For the month of November 2020, based on the graph, male has the highest number of registered deaths compared to the number of deaths of the female.
- In terms of the civil status of the death, 29.27% of them were single, 51.01% were married and 19.72% were widow/widower.
- With regards to corpse disposal, 79.36 percent of death went through interment while 20.64 percent were cremated. A decreased of 20.29% on cremated deaths this month.
