DVSS MAY 2020 (VITAL STATISTICS RIZAL INDICATORS)

Date of Release: July 10, 2020

This report summarizes the data gathered from May 2020 documents submitted from the local civil registry offices of the thirteen municipalities and a city in the province of Rizal. The number of vital events in Rizal for reached 4,421 registered documents.

This represents 158.69% increased from the 1,709 registered vital events from the previous month. An extreme increased of registration because of the shifted guidelines from Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) to an eased General Community Quarantine (GCQ) in the province. The province generated the following statistics: 2,902 for birth, 54 for marriage and 1,465 for death.

Civil registration is a continuous, permanent, and compulsory recording of vital events occurring in the life of an individual such as birth, marriage, and death as well as court decrees, and legal instruments affecting his civil status in appropriate registers as mandated by Act No. 3753, the Civil Registry Law.

In this May 2020 issue, the Philippine Statistics Authority of Rizal presents the number of births, marriages, and deaths registered by municipalities in the province. The data are preliminary result from the Decentralized Vital Statistics System 2011 based on the documents submitted (Timely and Late Registered) by the Local Civil Registry Offices in Rizal.

BIRTH STATISTICS

- Province of Rizal recorded 2,069 timely registered births for the month of May 2020. City of Antipolo has the highest contribution of live births with 530, followed by Taytay with 336 and Rodriguez with 235. (see Table B).
- There were 66 newborn babies daily in the province for the month of May 2020.
- The timely data recorded presented 50.80 percent for the males and 49.20 percent for the females. It means that male born babies was higher by 3.24 percent than the female born babies for this month.
- About 1,277 births (61.72%) were attended by physicians followed by midwives, 725 (35.04%) while 65 (3.14%) were attended by hilot. (see Table C).
- 31.13 percent or 644 of the mothers in the province had their first-born baby for the month of May 2020.

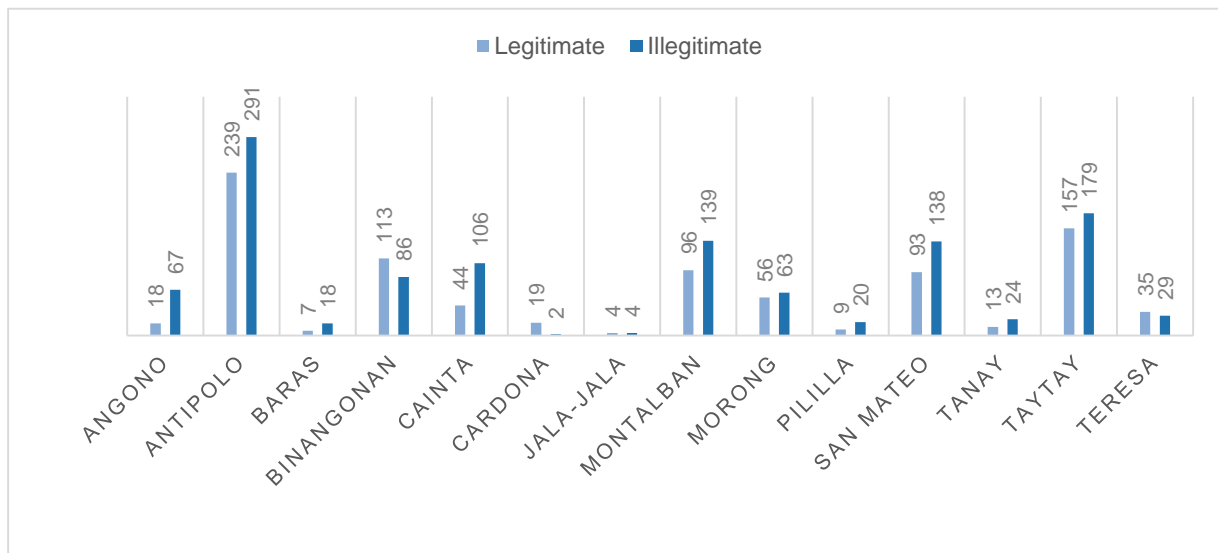

Out of fourteen city/municipalities, Bara, Pililla and Tanay have no recorded birth attended by physicians. Municipality of San Mateo, Taytay and Teresa have no recorded birth registration for this month.

More than fifty percent (447 or 58.20%) of babies born in Rizal were legitimate. Municipality of Cardona posted the highest legitimacy percentage with 7 or 100 percent of the total born children in the municipality level while Municipality of Cainta showed the highest illegitimacy percentage with 81 or 73.64 percent of the born children this month (see *Figure II*).

Modal age group for mothers was at 25 to 29 with 216 occurrences (28.13%). Teenage mothers (19 and below) listed 54 births or 7.03 percent. While the non-fertile age group (45 and over) showed fertility performance at two (2) recorded live births or 0.26 percent.

MARRIAGE STATISTICS

- As the table shows, month of April has 12 timely registered marriages compare to 467 of the previous month (*refer to Table E*). It was 97.43 percent decrease due to implementation of ECQ in the province that limits gatherings and celebrations to observe social distancing as a protocol to IATF guidelines.

- Eight out of fourteen city/municipality in the province had no recorded marriage documents for this month. The city/municipality that has the highest number of timely marriages recorded in Rodriguez with 6 registered documents, followed by Binangonan with 2 registered documents.

- The municipality of Rodriguez recorded 3 on civil ceremonies and 3 marriages officiated in other religion/religious sect.

- There were no recorded widows/widowers and divorced / separated on bride's and groom's civil status.

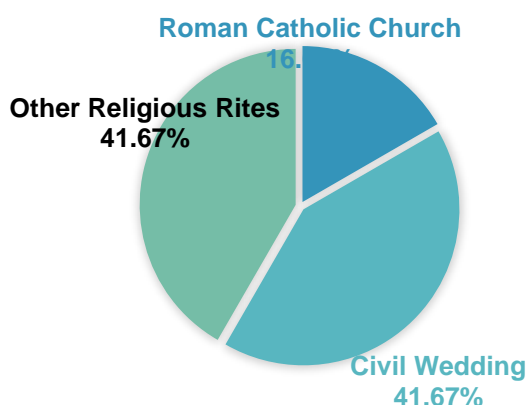

Modal age group for bride was 25-29 with 5 occurrences (41.67%) while modal age group for groom was 30- 34 with 6 occurrences (50.00%). No recorded teen bride and teen groom for this month. (See Table F).

- Province-wide, civil ceremonies initiated by the local chief executives in coordination with the municipal civil registrars including those solemnized by judges and ceremonies officiated in other religion/religious rites both got the highest number of registrations with 5 (41.67%).
- Roman Catholic ceremonies recorded 2 event or 16.67 percent.

The province also generated 859 timely registered deaths for the month of April. Antipolo City was on the top with 344 deaths, followed by Rodriguez with 123 deaths and Cainta with 108. Municipality of Morong has the least number of deaths with 1 record. For this month Municipality of San Mateo and Taytay have no recorded death statistics due to suspended office transactions during ECQ.

Records showed that there were 18 timely infant deaths in total. Municipality of Binangonan and Rodriguez recorded four (4) each. Meanwhile Jalajala, Morong, Pililla, Tanay and Teresa San Mateo and Teresa have no registered documents on infant deaths.

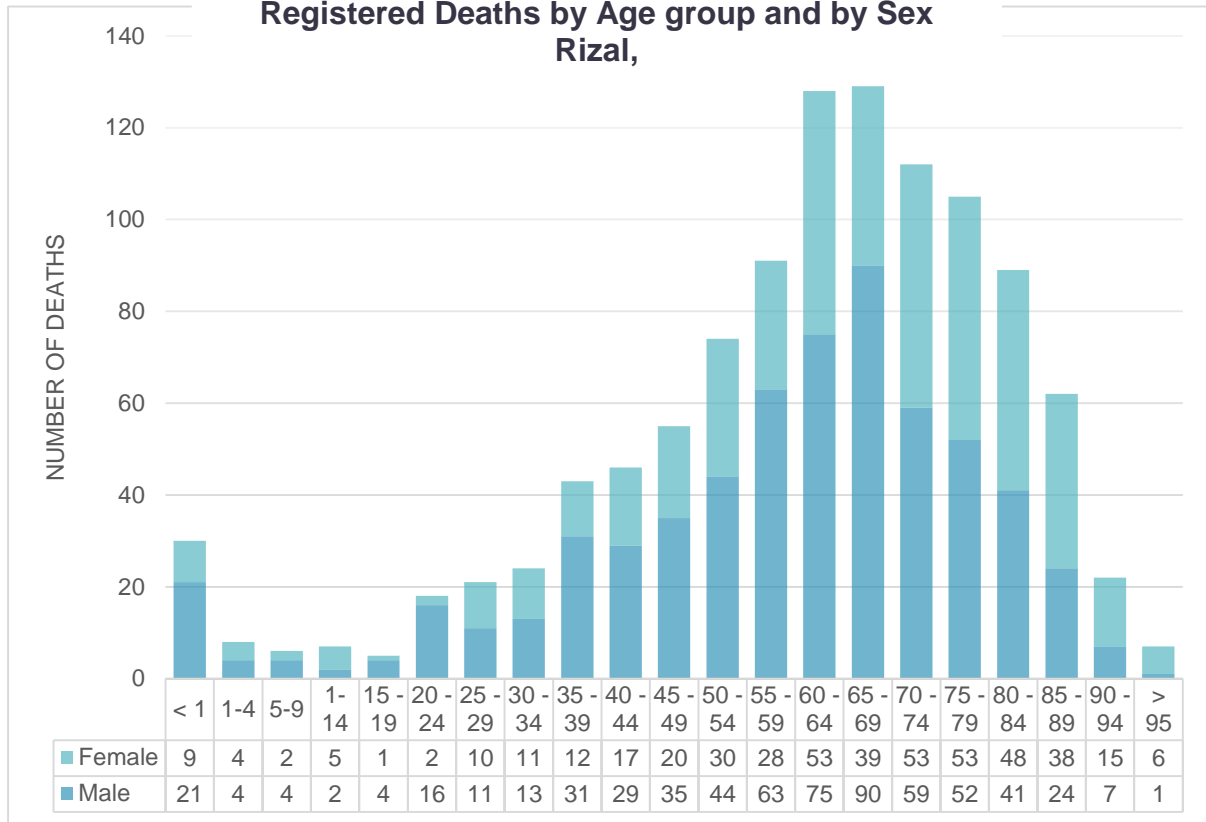
The modal age for the number of deaths was at 65-69 years old with 103 timely registered occurrences in April 2020.

Figure IV. Timely Registered Deaths by Sex and by Municipality

- 714 or 66.11 percent of the registered deaths in the province died in their homes, whereas about 366 or 33.89 percent died at hospitals.
- 76.02 percent been medically attended by the physicians, public health officer and in hospital before they died.

- Based on the graph, highest number of deaths for male was on the ages 65-69 years old, while for female, the highest number of deaths was on the ages 60-64,70- 74 and 75- 79 with 53 deaths respectively (see Figure V.)
- For the month of March 2020, based on the graph, male has the highest number of registered deaths compared to the number of deaths of the female.
- In terms of the civil status of the death, 30.00% of them were single, 47.87% were married and 21.94% were widow/widower.
- In regards to corpse disposal, 85.12 percent of death went through interment while 14.79 percent were cremated, an increase of 73 cremated deaths from the previous month.
