



# SPECIAL RELEASE

## DVSS MAY 2022 (VITAL STATISTICS RIZAL INDICATORS)

Date of Release: July 29, 2022

This report summarizes the administrative data gathered from May 2022 documents submitted by the local civil registry offices of the thirteen municipalities and a city in the province of Rizal. The number of vital events in Rizal for the reference month reached 6,119.

This represents 1.56% increase from the 5,932 registered vital events from the previous month. The province generated the following statistics: three thousand and eight hundred ninety four (3,894) for birth, nine hundred twenty two (922) for marriage and one thousand three hundred three (1,303) for death.

Civil registration is a continuous, permanent, and compulsory recording of vital events occurring in the life of an individual such as birth, marriage, and death as well as court decrees, and legal instruments affecting his civil status in appropriate registers as mandated by Act No. 3753, the Civil Registry Law.

In this May 2022 issue, the Philippine Statistics Authority of Rizal presents the number of births, marriages, and deaths registered by municipalities in the province. The data are preliminary result from the Decentralized Vital Statistics System 2011 based on the documents submitted (Timely and Late Registered) by the Local Civil Registry Offices in Rizal.

## BIRTH STATISTICS

- Province of Rizal recorded 2,524 timely registered births for the month of May 2022. City of Antipolo had the highest contribution of live births with 858 followed by Montalban with 357 and Taytay with 294. Municipality of Jalajala had the least contribution with 6 live births (see *Table B*).
- There were almost 81 newborn babies daily in the province for the month of May 2022.
- The timely data recorded presented 51.19 percent for the males and 48.81 percent for the females. It means that male born babies were higher by only 2.38 percent than the female born babies for this month.
- About 1,771 births (70.17%) were attended by physicians followed by Midwife which is 594 (23.53%), while 157 (6.22 %) were attended by Hilot, 1 (0.04%) were attended by nurse and 1 (0.04%) were attended by other type of attendant at birth (*See Table C*).
- 31.50 percent or 795 of the mothers in the province had their first-born during the reference month.

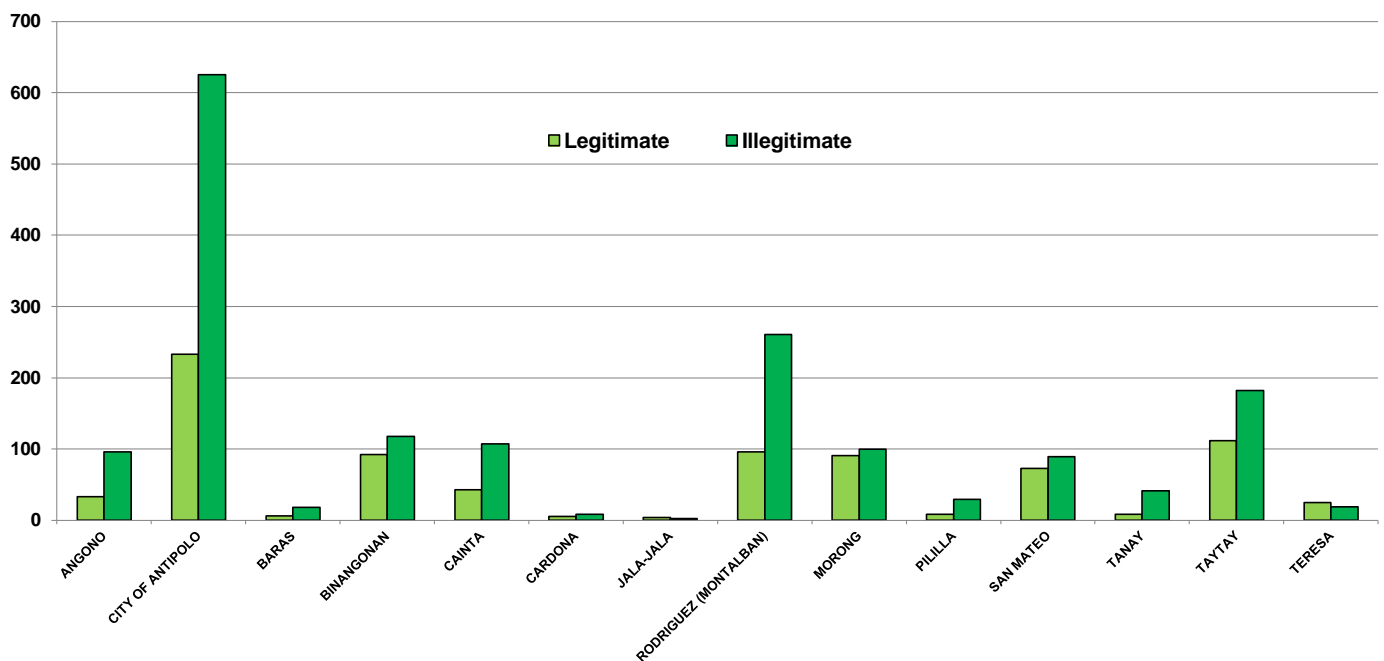

Out of the fourteen (14) city/municipalities, Baras and Pililla have no recorded birth attended by physicians, followed by Tanay with one (1) birth registration and Jalajala with four (4).

Thirty two point eighty four (829) babies born in Rizal were legitimate. City of Antipolo posted the highest legitimacy percentage of 26.11% (33) of the total born children in the province of Rizal as well as the highest illegitimacy percentage of 36.87% (625) born this month (see *Figure I*).

City of Antipolo has the biggest gap between legitimate and illegitimate.

Modal age group for mothers was at 25 to 29 years old with 784 occurrences (31.06%). Teenage mothers (19 years old and below) listed 207 births or 8.20% in which; six (6) teenage mother were age under 15. The non-fertile age group (45 years old and over) showed fertility performance with five (5) recorded live births or 0.20 percent.

# MARRIAGE STATISTICS

- As the table shows, month of April had 878 timely registered marriages compared to 872 of the previous month with a recorded increase of 0.34 percent in registration.

- The city/municipality with the highest number of timely registered marriages was recorded in the City of Antipolo with 251 registered documents, followed by Taytay with 115 and Montalban with 84 registered marriages. (See table E.)

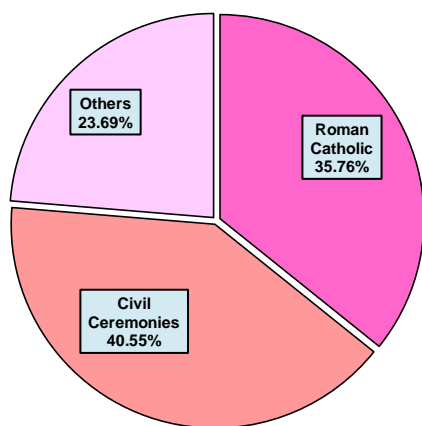
- The City of Antipolo having the highest registered marriages in the province of Rizal, documented Catholic marriages as the most officiated with one hundred and forty seven (147) instances, as well as in Other Religious Rites with sixty five (65) while, Taytay had recorded highest in Civil Ceremonies with sixty one (61) instances.

- There was fourteen (14) recorded widow on bride's civil status and twelve (12) widowers on the grooms.

- Province-wide, civil ceremonies initiated by the local chief executives in coordination with the municipal civil registrars including those solemnized by judges, recorded the highest number of registrations with 356 (40.55%).
- Ceremonies officiated by other religious sectors recorded 208 events or 23.69 percent.
- Roman Catholic ceremonies recorded 314 events or 35.76 percent. (refer to Figure II)

Teen bride had sixteen (16) or 1.82% recorded marriages while teen groom had three (3) or 0.34% recorded events this month. There was two (2) recorded groom who got married with age of 75 years old and over that tied the knot. The modal age group for groom and bride was at 25- 29 years old with 334 grooms and 361 brides (See Table F).

In Rizal, there were 37 Filipinas married to foreign nationals that were registered in April 2022 (See table G).



Registered death records on children under one-year old decreased by 5 deaths compared to previous month.

## DEATH STATISTICS

The province generated 1,288 timely registered deaths for the month of April 2022. Antipolo City was on the top with three hundred seventeen (317) deaths, followed by Binangonan with one hundred eighty six (186) deaths and Montalban with one hundred seventy two (172). Municipality of Jalajala has the least number of deaths with nineteen (19).

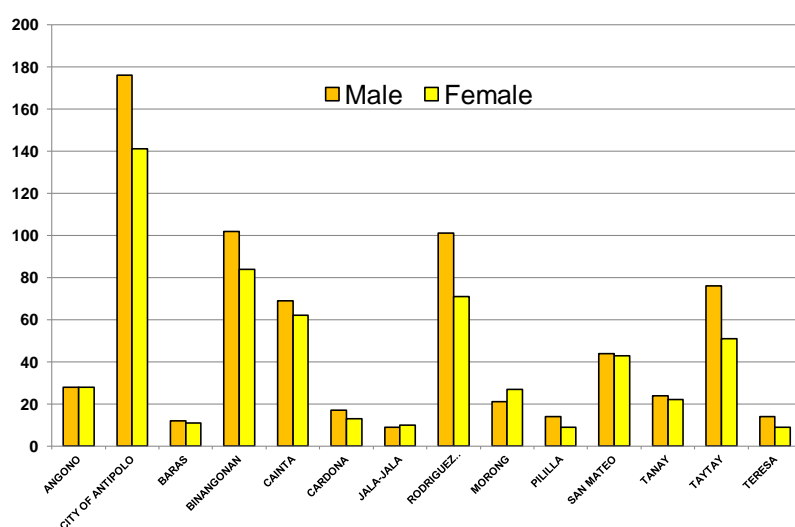
Records showed that there were 29 timely infant deaths in total. City of Antipolo recorded the highest with seven (7) infant deaths. Meanwhile, Baras, Cardona, Jalajala, and Pililla have no registered documents on infant deaths.

The modal age group for the number of timely registered deaths was at 65 to 69 years old with 148 occurrences in May 2022.

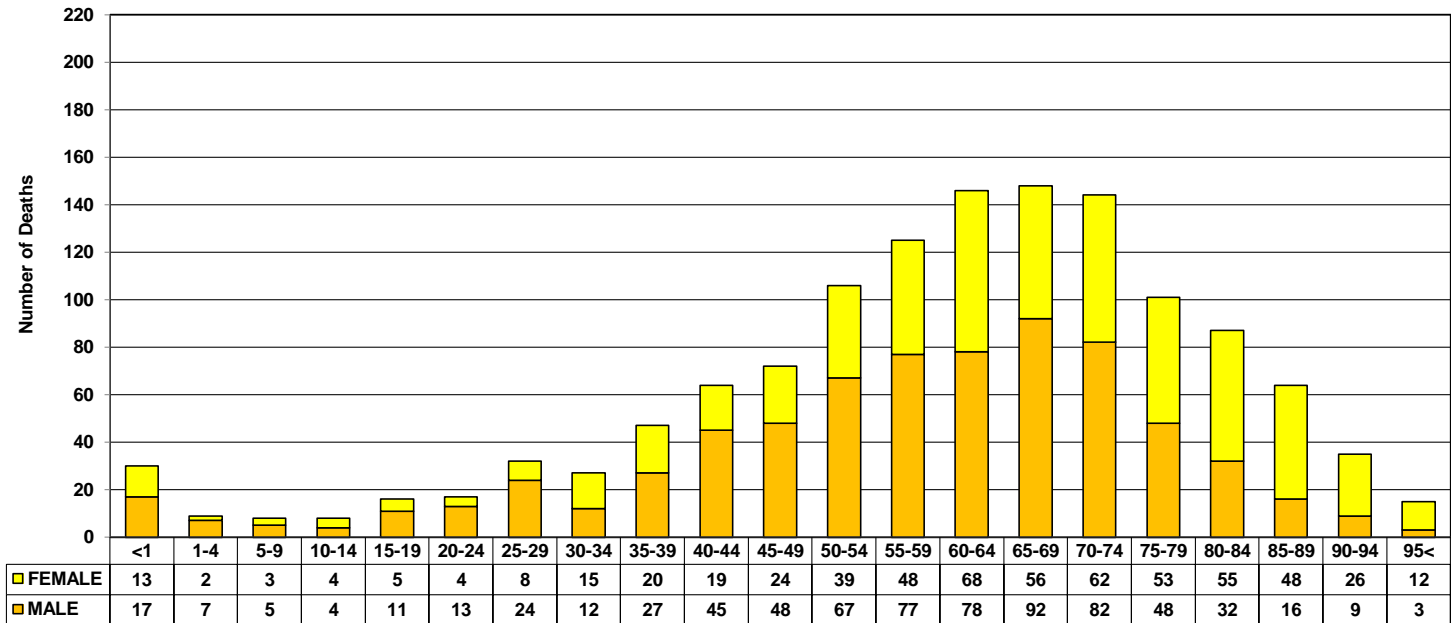
**Figure III. Timely Registered Deaths by Sex and by City/Municipality Rizal: May 2022**

Seven Hundred and Fifty Nine or 58.93 percent of the registered deaths in the province died in their homes, whereas about 528 or 40.84 percent passed away in hospitals and 3 or 0.23 percent were deceased in places other than those mentioned above.

Forty point eighty four percent has been medically attended by the physicians, public health officer and in hospital before they pass away.

**Age Group**

- Based on the graph, the highest number of deaths for Male was at age 65 to 69 years old with 92 total deaths. On the other hand; at the highest number of deaths for Female was on an age of 60 to 64 years old with a total of 68 deaths (See Figure IV).
- For the month of May 2022, male had the highest number of registered deaths compared to the number of deaths of the female.
- In terms of the civil status, 30.51% were single, 46.66% were married, 22.75% were widow/widower, and 0.178 percent civil statuses were not stated.
- With regard to corpse disposal, 84.57% of death went through burial, 15.43% were cremated.
