Among the 17 regions in the country, Region IV-A had the most number of NSM activities conducted in 2019 with a total of 439 activities, followed by NCR and CAR, with 220 and 168 NSM activities;
6. Participated in the 4th Regional Statistics Committee Summit and awarded as the Best RSC in Luzon and Overall for 2019;
7. Conducted 4 regular meetings, 1 technical working group meeting for the updating of 2019 RSET.
