- 7. Address data gaps in the establishment of Regional Sustainable Development Goal Indicators and Core Regional Indicators
- 8. Coordination and consolidation of quarterly data for the Regional Economic Situationer and annual data for the Regional Development Report
- 9. Generation of more gender specific data for the CALABARZON Women and Men Statistical Journal
- 10. Conduct of local advocacy activities for the generation of disaster statistics including road crash statistics
- 11. Coordination of the implementation of Community Based Monitoring System
- 12. Conduct of four RSC quarterly meetings with at least 81 percent participation rate
