RSC Resolution No. IV-A-15-2021

“REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT REGION IV-A TO ISSUE A MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR ENCOURAGING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS TO MIGRATE TO ELECTRONIC BUSINESS PERMITS AND LICENSING SYSTEM DEVELOPED BY DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY”

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 11032 or the Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018 was enacted on May 28, 2018, amending Republic Act No. 9485, to provide a program for the adoption of simplified requirements and procedures that will reduce red tape and expedite business and non-business related transactions in government;

WHEREAS, Section 11 of RA 11032 mandates the cities/municipalities to automate their business permitting and licensing system or setup an electronic Business One Stop Shop until 2021 for a more efficient business registration processes;

WHEREAS, Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) developed and offered the electronic Business Permits and Licensing System (eBPLS) to local government units (LGUs) pursuant to Section 26 of RA 11032 which mandates DICT, in coordination with Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) and Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), to automate business-related transactions by developing the necessary software and technology-neutral platforms and secure infrastructure that is web-based and accessible to the public;

WHEREAS, DICT Luzon Cluster 2, during the RSC 4th Quarter 2021 Meeting reported that only 24 percent or 34 LGUs in CALABARZON have operational eBPLS, 17 LGUs for data buildup, and 14 LGUs for training;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED,** to request Department of Interior and Local Government Region IV-A to issue a memorandum circular encouraging the LGUs to migrate to electronic business permits and licensing system developed by Department of Information and Communications Technology;
