"REQUESTING AGENCIES TO PROVIDE PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY REGION IV-A WITH UP-TO-DATE SEX-DISAGGREGATED DATA FOR CALABARZON WOMEN AND MEN STATISTICAL JOURNAL"

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 9710 "An Act Providing for the Magna Carta of Women" recognize the role of women in nation building and ensures the substantive equality of women and men in terms of opportunities and access to resources and to development results and outcomes;

WHEREAS, RA 9710 declares that the State shall endeavor to develop plans, policies, programs, measures, and mechanisms to address discrimination and inequality in the economic, political, social, and cultural life of women and men:

WHEREAS, in order to implement the provisions of RA 9710 and implement Gender and Development mainstreaming, sex-disaggregated data is needed;

WHEREAS, since 2018, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) had been consolidating women and men data sourced from different census and survey results and from administrative data of regional line agencies to answer the need for sex-disaggregated data;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to request agencies to provide PSA Region IV-A with up-to-date sex-disaggregated data for CALABARZON Women and Men Statistical Journal.
