"REQUESTING THE SUPPORT OF THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES AND INSTRUMENTALITIES, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS FOR THE CREATION OF CALABARZON INTEGRATED STATISTICS WEB PORTAL"

- WHEREAS, the CALABARZON Regional Statistical Development Program (RSDP) 2018-2023 aims to develop and improve the statistical processes in the CALABARZON Regional Statistical System (RSS) for better information management, dissemination, and communication of timely and relevant official statistics;
- WHEREAS, Chapter III of the CALABARZON RSDP 2018-2023 discusses the strategies for the effective and efficient management and dissemination of statistical information where one of the statistical development programs identified is the implementation of integrated statistics web portal;
- whereas, the integrated statistics web portal will serve as the central facility of all sectoral statistics of regional government agencies and instrumentalities, and local government units in CALABARZON that will facilitate consolidation, sharing and dissemination of available data and metadata in the CALABARZON RSS;
- NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to request the support of the regional government agencies and instrumentalities, and local government units for the creation of CALABARZON integrated statistics web portal;
- **RESOLVED FURTHER,** to request the regional government agencies and instrumentalities, and local government units to commit to the following:
 - 1. Share the lists of their data holdings to PSA Region IV-A for inclusion in the statistics web portal;
 - 2. Provide links to their website where the information and statistics can be accessed;
 - 3. Regularly update the information and statistics on their website; and
 - 4. Provide PSA Region IV-A the data/statistics that will be uploaded in the statistics web portal.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to endorse the request to the Regional Development Council through the Sectoral Committee on Macroeconomy and Development Administration.
