Major Accomplishments of RSC CALABARZON in 2023

I. Statistical Planning and Coordination

- a. A total of 41 policy agenda were approved and discussed in the quarterly meetings of the RSC in 2023, wherein 54 percent or 22 resolutions were approved by the committee.
- b. Conducted four regular meetings in 2023 with 85.8 percent average participation rate and one Technical Working Group meeting on the compilation of water accounts.

II. Statistical Advocacy

- a. Advocated the adoption of the Statistical Standard and Classification Systems in the CALABARZON Regional Statistical System.
- b. Spearheaded the month-long celebration of the 34th National Statistics Month (NSM) which featured various activities involving the different regional line agencies (RLAs), local government units (LGUs), academe, media, and the private sector through online and face-to-face platforms.
- c. A total of 623 NSM activities were conducted in the region, of which 71 percent are advocacy activities such as hanging of streamers at various places and posting of posters on websites and social media accounts.

III. Data Dissemination and Use

- a. Maintained and updated the 2023 CALABARZON Regional Social and Economic Trends, Core Regional Indicators, Sustainable Development Goals Watch, and Core Gender and Development Indicators.
- b. Advocated the establishment of Data Enclave Center.

IV. Statistical Capacity Building

The following are the conducted trainings based on the approved 2023 Statistical Training Programs by the RSC CALABARZON attended by different RLAs, LGUs, and academe:
