Major accomplishments of RSC CALABARZON in 2024

I. Statistical Planning and Coordination

- a. Conducted four regular meetings in 2024 with 87.5 percent average participation rate and an average of 4.71 evaluation rating.
- b. A total of 42 policy agenda were approved and discussed in the quarterly meetings, wherein 57.1 percent or 24 resolutions were approved by the committee.

II. Statistical Advocacy

- a. Advocated the adoption of the Statistical Standards and Classification Systems in the CALABARZON Regional Statistical System.
- b. Spearheaded the month-long celebration of the 35th National Statistics Month (NSM) in the region which featured various activities involving the different regional line agencies (RLAs), local government units (LGUs), academe, media, and the private sector through online and face-to-face platforms.

A total of 200 NSM activities were conducted in the region, with 30.5 percent are advocacy activities which included hanging of streamers at various places in the region and posting of posters at websites and in social media accounts.

III. Data Dissemination and Use

a. Maintained and updated the 2024 CALABARZON Regional Social and Economic Trends and Core Regional Indicators, Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Watch and Pace of Progress and Core Gender and Development Indicators.

IV. Statistical Capacity Building

The following are conducted based on the approved 2024 Proposed Statistical Training Programs by the RSC CALABARZON. These trainings were attended by various RLAs, LGUs, higher education institutions, and other invited regional stakeholders.
