WHEREAS, the Calabarzon Regional Statistical Development Program (RSDP) 2018-2023 provides the directions, thrusts and priorities of the Regional Statistical System that will generate local level data and resolve statistical issues align with the Philippine Statistical Development Program (PSDP) 2018-2023;
