- WHEREAS, one of the powers and functions of the Regional Statistics Committee (RSC) as provided in PSA Board Resolution No. 5, Series of 2015, PSA Board Resolution No. 03, Series of 2017, and PSA Board Resolution No. 01, Series 2018, is to "create Inter-agency Statistical Working Groups, as the need arises, that could attend to technical issues and problems and supervise the activities of these working groups";
- WHEREAS, RSC Resolution No. IV-A-03-2018 approved the creation of the Sectoral Working Groups (SWGs) for the formulation of the Calabarzon Regional Statistical Development Program (RSDP) 2018-2023;
- WHEREAS, the Calabarzon RSDP 2018-2023 was approved by RSC IV-A through RSC Resolution No. IV-A-05-2018, Series of 2018;
- WHEREAS, there is a need to create SWGs that will convene ad hoc meetings, in order to facilitate the implementation of the Statistical Development Programs (SDPs) stated in the Calabarzon RSDP 2018-2023;
- NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to establish the sectoral working groups under the supervision of RSC IV-A for the implementation of the statistical development programs stipulated in the Calabarzon RSDP 2018-2023;
- **RESOLVED FINALLY,** that the terms of reference of the SWGs (attached) forms part of this resolution;

Sectoral Working Groups on the Implementation of Statistical Development Programs

Terms of Reference

I. Duties and responsibilities

The Sectoral Working Groups (SWGs) shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- 1. Serve as a venue for the exchange of views and expertise to resolve statistical issues and concerns, arising from the production, dissemination, and use of statistics stated in the Calabarzon RSDP 2018-2023.
- 2. Serve as a venue for the monitoring of the implementation of statistical development programs (SDPs), with the support of regional line agencies, local government units, and other stakeholders.
- 3. Recommend to the RSC IV-A and the PSA Board an efficient workable scheme for the allocation of budget of concerned agencies for the implementation of SDPs for each calendar year.
- 4. Recommend to the RSC IV-A, and/or the PSA Board appropriate measures for the improvement of local-level statistics in Calabarzon, including the statistical frameworks, methodologies and processes for the generation and dissemination of statistics.
- 5. Address evolving and emerging statistical requirements of stakeholders in the Calabarzon Regional Statistical System.
- 6. Prioritize outputs for the implementation of SDPs stipulated in the Calabarzon RSDP 2018-2023, especially those that are required to monitor the progress of the development programs set forth in the Calabarzon Regional Development Plan 2017-2023.
- 7. Submit to the RSC IV-A their annual work programs and report on the progress of their work, including findings and recommendations on technical issues referred to them.
