RSC Resolution No. IV-A-13-2023

"ENJOINING REGIONAL LINE AGENCIES, LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS, AND STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES IN CALABARZON TO PROVIDE KEY INFORMATION RELEVANT TO THE MANAGEMENT AND COORDINATION OF THE REGIONAL STATISTICAL SYSTEM"

WHEREAS, the CALABARZON Regional Statistical Development Program 2018-2023 identifies the need for strengthened coordination mechanisms at all levels to ensure timely delivery of quality statistical information and services, sustainable financing for the statistical activities of the Regional Statistical System (RSS), and establishment of statistical units or positions in the regional line agencies, local government units (LGUs), and state universities and colleges to perform statistical functions that will handle necessary statistical work in support to the data requirements of the Regional Development Plan, local governance, and socioeconomic development, among others;

WHEREAS, the Regional Statistics Committee (RSC) through RSC Resolution No. IV-A-07-2019 and the Regional Development Council (RDC) through RDC Resolution No. IV-A-111-2019 requested the LGUs, national government agencies, and government-owned and controlled corporations in CALABARZON to designate statistical personnel pending the establishment of the needed statistical units/positions to ensure sustained production, dissemination and use of data for development planning and monitoring purposes;

WHEREAS, Rule III, Section 4 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 11315 or the Community Based Monitoring System (CBMS) Act also states that each city and municipality shall have a statistician who shall be responsible for data collection; data processing; mapping and geotagging; database management which includes preservation and safekeeping of the data retained at the city or municipal level; and ensure the dissemination of CBMS data to internal users;

WHEREAS, for planning and implementation of statistical development programs in the region, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Region IV-A as the Chair of the Sectoral Working Group on RSS Wide Concerns shall gather information relevant to the management and coordination of the CALABARZON RSS, statistical capacity development, and statistical information management and dissemination;



NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to enjoin the regional line agencies, local government units, and state universities and colleges in CALABARZON to provide key information relevant to the management and coordination of the regional statistical system.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to request the regional line agencies, local government units. and state universities and colleges to accomplish ANNEX A of this Resolution and submit to the PSA Region IV-A for consolidation.
