# "ADOPTION OF THE PHILIPPINE SOCIAL PROTECTION STATISTICAL FRAMEWORK FOR CALABARZON"

- WHEREAS, providing a universal and integrated Social Protection (SP) system to build the resiliency and adaptive capacity of the population is among the priority strategies in the Philippine and CALABARZON Regional Development Plans:
- WHEREAS, Chapter 9 of the CALABARZON Regional Statistical Development Program 2018-2023 highlighted the need for baseline information against which social protection outcomes can be defined and measured;
- WHEREAS, Philippine Statistics Authority Board Resolution No. 12, series of 2021, approved the adoption of the Philippine Social Protection Statistical Framework (PSPSF) as shown in Annex A-14-2023, which forms part of this Resolution:
- WHEREAS, the PSPSF identified the risks and vulnerabilities and its subsequent indicators to address the need for reliable, accurate, and timely data on the status of the vulnerable and marginalized sectors:
- WHEREAS, reliable data/information is needed by the government agencies, local government units, non-governmental organizations, and other public/private entities to develop plans, programs, and policies that will address the plight of the vulnerable and marginalized sector including persons with disabilities, informal sector workers, indigenous peoples, and internally displaced persons;
- NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to adopt the Philippine Social Protection Statistical Framework for CALABARZON.
- RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Regional Statistics Committee and other data providers shall: a) provide data support; b) assess and classify available SP indicators based on definition, methodology, coverage, frequency of release, and disaggregation, among others; c) ensure that the concepts and definitions are aligned with internationally-agreed guidelines and recommendation; and d) identify additional indicators that are crucial for policymaking, promotion, development, and evaluation of the social protection sector.
