RSC Resolution No. IV-A-20-2024

“ADOPTING THE 2014-2023 COMPENDIUM OF CALABARZON ENVIRONMENT STATISTICS – COMPONENT 3: RESIDUALS”

WHEREAS, Republic Act of 10625 also known as the Philippine Statistical Act of 2013 mandates the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) to collect, compile, analyze, abstract, and publish statistical information relating to the country's economic, social, demographic, political affairs and general activities and condition of the people;

WHEREAS, the Compendium of CALABARZON Environment Statistics (CCES) is included in the Regional Statistical Development Program to serve as basis for policies and programs to address the need for local level environment-related statistics;

WHEREAS, RSC Resolution No. IV-A-18-2023 enjoined the government agencies, local government units, and private sector organizations to provide data support in the compilation of environment statistics of the region;

WHEREAS, PSA Region IV-A compiled the Component 3: Residuals of the CCES with available data on the generation and management of waste for the period 2014 to 2023 from the Environmental Management Bureau of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources;

WHEREAS, the projected waste generation of CALABARZON decreased to 9,725 tons per day in 2023, a 3.95 percent decrease from the previous year. Additionally, CALABARZON generated a total of 111.61 thousand tons of hazardous wastes, of which 103.28 thousand tons were treated;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED,** to adopt the 2014-2023 Compendium of CALABARZON Environment Statistics – Component 3: Residuals.
