CY 2018 Accomplishment Report**

1. Coordinated, consolidated and conducted statistics related activities:
 - a. CALABARZON Calendar of Statistical Activities in celebration of the 29th National Statistics Month;
 - b. Updating of the 2018 CALABARZON Regional Social and Economic Trends and Core Regional Indicators;
 - c. Validation of the 2017 Gross Regional Domestic Product Indicators;
 - d. Consultation workshops on the statistical programs and activities of different agencies, local government units, academe and other government offices including the statistical issues and challenges;
2. Completed data requirements for the Quarterly Regional Economic Situationer and 2017 Regional Development Report;
3. Advocated and supported the 2017 Gross Regional Domestic Product, Core Regional Indicators (CoRe-Is), Core Sustainable Development Goals Indicators (Core SDGIs), Statistical Survey Review and Clearance System (SSRCS), and formulation and implementation of the CALABARZON Regional Statistical Development Program;
4. Formulated and approved the CALABARZON Regional Statistical Development Program 2018-2023;
5. Supported and conducted various activities in celebration of the 29th National Statistics Month such as the NSM Opening Ceremony, CALABARZON Research and Statistics Forum, and Economic and Financial Inclusion Forum. Region IV-A posted the 2nd highest rate of increase in NSM activities conducted at 143.9%;
6. Participated in the 3rd Regional Statistics Committee Summit and presented the best practices of the region;
7. Released the first publication of the CALABARZON Women and Men Statistical Handbook;
8. Conducted 4 regular meetings, 1 special meeting for the approval of RSDP, 2 technical working group meetings for the validation of 2017 GRDP and updating of 2018 RSET, 1 focus group discussion on agricultural statistics, 4 bilateral consultations with NEDA IV-A, DENR IV-A, DOST IV-A, and UPLB InStat and 4 sectoral working group consultation workshops for the formulation of RSDP.
