"REQUESTING THE SUPPORT AND PARTICIPATION OF REGIONAL LINE AGENCIES, LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS, AND ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS IN THE ASSESSMENT AND MAPPING OF THE CALABARZON'S DATA ECOSYSTEM"

- WHEREAS,** the 2018-2023 CALABARZON Regional Statistical Development Program (RSDP) envisions a responsive, effective and efficient Regional Statistical System (RSS) that provides quality statistics for evidenced-based decisions towards the attainment of development goals of the region;
- WHEREAS,** the CALABARZON RSDP includes the continuous conduct of assessment and evaluation of the CALABARZON region's data ecosystem, by socio-economic sector to determine the areas needing for improvement;
- WHEREAS,** there is a need to assess the current state of the sectoral and the CALABARZON's data ecosystems on data communities, laws and policy frameworks, platforms and tools used, technologies utilized, institutions involved and types of data;
- WHEREAS,** the assessment of the current CALABARZON regional statistical system will be used in the preparation of the ideal state of sectoral data ecosystems needed to address data demands, issues and concerns on business processes, policies, infrastructure and capacity;
- WHEREAS,** the mapping of the current and ideal state of sectoral and regional data ecosystem would draw on existing and new sources of data to fully integrate statistics into decision-making, promote open access to, and use of data, and ensure increased support for statistical systems;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED,** to request the support and participation of regional line agencies, local government units (LGUs), and academic institutions in the assessment and mapping of the CALABARZON's data ecosystem;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the agencies, LGUs and academic institutions shall furnish the RSC CALABARZON through Philippine Statistics Authority IV-A with relevant information or indicators needed for the assessment and mapping of the CALABARZON's data ecosystem on or before September 30, 2019;
