RSC Resolution No. IV-A-10-2019

**“REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE FISHERIES DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (PFDA) LUCENA AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS OF ROSARIO, CAVITE AND ATIMONAN AND INFANTA, QUEZON TO SUBMIT MONTHLY REPORT ON PRICE AND VOLUME OF FISH UNLOADINGS TO PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY IV-A”**

**WHEREAS,** the Regional Statistics Committee (RSC) is the highest policy-making and coordinating body on statistical matters in the region;

**WHEREAS,** one of the priority thrusts of the Calabarzon RSC is to recommend actions to address statistical related concerns;

**WHEREAS,** one of the pressing statistical related concerns of the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) is the need for a more timely and standardized reporting on the price and volume of fish unloadings in the landing centers of Dalahican, Quezon being managed by Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) and the local government unit (LGU)-managed fish landing centers of Rosario, Cavite and Atimonan and Infanta in the province of Quezon;

**WHEREAS,** the reports on the volume and value of fish unloadings at the aforesaid PFDA and LGU-managed fish landing centers are being used by the PSA IV-A as administrative data to complement the results of PSA's quarterly fishery production survey and come up with indicators in measuring the performance of the fishery sub-sector in the region;

**WHEREAS,** the quarterly reports on the volume and value of fish production also serves as inputs for the estimation of the Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP) of Calabarzon specifically for the Agriculture and Fishery industry sector;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** on motion duly seconded, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED,** to request PFDA Lucena and LGU's of Rosario, Cavite and Atimonan and Infanta, Quezon to submit monthly report on price and volume of fish unloadings to PSA IV-A;

**RESOLVED FURTHER,** that PFDA Lucena and LGU's of Rosario, Cavite and Atimonan and Infanta, Quezon shall submit to their respective counterpart (PSA Quezon and PSA Cavite) their monthly reports not later than the 1<sup>st</sup> week of the month following the reference month starting October 2019 forward for the regular conduct of Provincial and Regional Data Review of the PSA;

**RESOLVED FURTHERMORE,** the said data sources will use the prescribed format (attached);
