RSC Resolution No. IV-A-12-2019

"REQUESTING THE DATA SOURCE AGENCIES TO SUBMIT THEIR DATA ON ROAD CRASH ACCIDENTS TO PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY IV-A"

- whereas, under the Republic Act of 10625, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) shall primarily be responsible for all national censuses and surveys, sectoral statistics, consolidation of selected administrative recording systems and compilation of national accounts;
- whereas, the 2018-2023 CALABARZON Regional Statistical Development Program includes in its key statistical development programs the improvement of administrative-based reporting and information systems and identification of new ones to collect or generate essential transport data;
- WHEREAS, RDC Resolution No. IV-A-114-2019 requested the PSA to serve as repository of data on road crash accidents being collected by the Philippine National Police, Land Transportation Office and local government units;
- **WHEREAS,** the data items being collected are the date, time and place of occurrence, vehicle types involved, gender and age of involved parties, severity of the crash and weather condition;
- WHEREAS, the data on road crash accidents will be included in the CALABARZON Regional Social and Economic Trends under Chapter 13 Transportation and Communication;
- NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to request the data source agencies to submit their data on road crash accidents to PSA IV-A;
- **RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the data source agencies shall use the prescribed format as provided in Annex A and shall submit every last week of April or as the need arises for the policy and decision making;
