03 February 2025, Trece Martires City - Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) – Cavite commemorates Civil Registration Month every February, as established by Presidential Proclamation No. 682, signed by former President Corazon C. Aquino on January 28, 1991. This year's theme, "Building a Resilient, Agile, and Future-fit Civil Registration and Vital Statistics System," emphasizes the crucial role of Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (CRVS) in creating a future where services are efficiently delivered, safeguarding the well-being and rights of every individual. It also serves as a reminder for citizens to fulfill their responsibility to register vital events such as births, deaths, and marriages.



To kick off the month-long celebration, PSA Cavite held a vibrant Launching Activity on February 3, 2025, at the Boochico Building in Trece Martires City, Cavite. The event was attended by PSA officials, employees, and several Civil Registrars from the province, who participated in a Thanksgiving Mass led by Rev. Fr. Calven Mark A. Banaybanay, Parochial Vicar of Our Lady of Immaculate Conception Parish in Dasmariñas City, Cavite.
