#### **DEFINITION OF TERMS**

- Consumer Price Index (CPI) is an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by household relative to base year.
- **Vital statistics-** are derived from information obtained at the time when the occurrences of vital events and their characteristics are inscribed in a civil register.
- Live Birth is a complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of a product of conception, irrespective of the duration of the pregnancy, which after such separation, breathes or shows any other evidence of life, such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles, whether or not the umbilical cord has been cut or the placenta is attached; each product of such a birth is considered liveborn.
- **Marriage i**s a contract of permanent union between a man and a woman entered into in accordance with law for the establishment of conjugal and family life.
- **Death** -refers to the permanent disappearance of all evidence of life at any time after live birth has taken place (postnatal cessation of vital function without capability of resuscitation).
- **Commercial Fisheries** cover fishing operations that make use of boats of more than three (3) gross tons
- **Municipal Fisheries** cover fishing operations carried out without the use of boat or the use of a boat of three (3) gross tons or less
- **Inland Fisheries** catching of fish, crustaceans, mollusks and all other aquatic animals and plants in inland water like lakes, rivers, dams, marshes, etc.
