MARRIAGE STATISTICS IN QUEZON: March 2024 (Preliminary Results)



Number of Marriages...

- There were 641 marriages registered in Quezon in March 2024. It recorded a decrease of 8.17 percent from the previous month's total of 698.
- ➤ The daily average of registered marriages during the month was 21, lower than the recorded daily average of 24 in February 2024.





Marriages by Place of Occurrence...

- ➤ San Francisco (86 or 13.4%) had the highest number of registered marriages, followed by Lucena City (74 or 11.5%) and Sariaya (62 or 9.7%).
- ➤ Buenavista with 49 or 7.6 percent and San Narciso with 48 or 7.5 percent recorded the next highest registered marriages.
- Around 48.8 percent of the 41 municipalities/cities in the province registered less than ten (10) marriage occurrences during the month.
- > No marriage event was recorded in the municipalities of Jomalig, Patnanungan and Pitogo.

Marriages by Month...

- For the period of March 2023 to March 2024, July was the most favored month to marry, with a total of 933 marriages, or a daily average of 30 marriages.
- May had the next highest number of marriages with 921 or a daily average of 30.
- August recorded the least number of marriages with 477 or a daily average of 15.

Marriages by Nationality of Groom and Bride...

- ➤ About 98.3 percent of the grooms and 99.5 percent of the brides were Filipinos in the registered marriages in March.
- There were eleven (11) intermarriages between Filipino brides and grooms of foreign descent and three (3) intermarriages between Filipino grooms and brides of foreign descent.

TECHNICAL NOTES

Vital Registration is a continuous process. Hence there is a need to specify certain cut-off period for purposes of reporting. The Marriage Statistics in Quezon presented in this report contains highlights and summary of statistical tables of marriages that occurred on or before March 2024 and registered within the said month. Events that occurred in March 2024 but were not registered during the month were not included in this publication. For this report, Vital Events Information (VEI) system was used in data encoding.
