BIRTH STATISTICS IN QUEZON: November 2024 (Preliminary Results)



Number of Live births...


- ➤ A total of 3,133 live births were registered in the province in November 2024. It recorded a decrease of 7.5 percent from the October 2024 figure of 3,386.
- Of the total births registered, 51.0 percent were males and 49.0 percent were females. This resulted to a birth sex ratio of 104 males for every 100 females.







- The daily average of birth occurrences during the month was 104, lower than the recorded daily average of 109 in October 2024.
- ➤ Lucena City recorded the highest number of live births with a total of 863 or 27.5 percent of the total births registered in the province. It was followed by Lopez and Candelaria with 321 or 10.2 percent and 257 or 8.2 percent, respectively.
- ➤ The three (3) municipalities with the least number of registered births were Panukulan (with 4 or 0.13%), Pitogo (with 3 or 0.10%), and Perez (with 2 or 0.06%).
- > No birth was registered in the municipality of Plaridel in November 2024.




Place of Occurrence and Usual Residence of Mother...

- Majority of the registered births were born to mothers whose usual residence is in Quezon province (3,042 or 97.1%).
- Only a small percentage of the birth occurrences (91 or 2.9%) were born to mothers whose usual residence is outside Quezon province.
- Nine (9) out of the 39 municipalities and 2 cities of Quezon province showed a positive difference in the number of births by place of occurrence and the usual place of residence of the mother. This implies that there were mothers who opted to give birth to places where there are available or better health care facilities and social services.
- ➤ The highest positive difference of 452 was reported in Lucena City. This may be attributed to higher number of hospitals and health care facilities located in the city.

In contrast, the highest negative difference of 110 was observed in Sariaya. This may be explained by its proximity to Lucena City where there are more health care facilities.



TECHNICAL NOTES

Vital Registration is a continuous process. Hence there is a need to specify certain cut-off period for purposes of reporting. The Birth Statistics in Quezon presented in this report contains highlights and summary of statistical tables of births that occurred on or before November 2024 and registered within the said month. Events that occurred in November 2024 but were not registered during the month were not included in this publication. For this report, Vital Events Information (VEI) system was used in data encoding.
