BIRTH STATISTICS IN QUEZON: July 2024 (Preliminary Results)



Number of Live births...


- ➤ A total of 3,544 live births were registered in the province in July 2024. It recorded an increase of 17.3 percent from the June 2024 figure of 3,021.
- ➤ Of the total births registered, 51.7 percent were males and 48.3 percent were females. This resulted to a birth sex ratio of 107 males for every 100 females.







- ➤ The daily average of birth occurrences during the month was 114, higher than the recorded daily average of 101 in June 2024.
- Lucena City recorded the highest number of live births with a total of 1,001 or 28.2 percent of the total births registered in the province. It was followed by Candelaria and Lopez with 240 or 6.8 percent and 225 or 6.3 percent, respectively.
- ➤ The three (3) municipalities with the least number of registered births were Agdangan and Panukulan (both with 3 or 0.08%), and Plaridel (1 or 0.03%).




Place of Occurrence and Usual Residence of Mother...

- Majority of the registered births were born to mothers whose usual residence is in Quezon province (3,483 or 98.3%).
- Only a small percentage of the birth occurrences (61or 1.7%) were born to mothers whose usual residence is outside Quezon province.
- Ten (10) out of the 39 municipalities and 2 cities of Quezon province showed a positive difference in the number of births by place of occurrence and the usual place of residence of the mother. This implies that there were mothers who opted to give birth to places where there are available or better health care facilities and social services.
- The highest positive difference of 486 was reported in Lucena City. This may be attributed to higher number of hospitals and health care facilities located in the city.



In contrast, the highest negative difference of 86 was observed in Pagbilao. This may be explained by its proximity to Lucena City where there are more health care facilities.



TECHNICAL NOTES

Vital Registration is a continuous process. Hence there is a need to specify certain cut-off period for purposes of reporting. The Birth Statistics in Quezon presented in this report contains highlights and summary of statistical tables of births that occurred on or before July 2024 and registered within the said month. Events that occurred in July 2024 but were not registered during the month were not included in this publication. For this report, Vital Events Information (VEI) system was used in data encoding.
