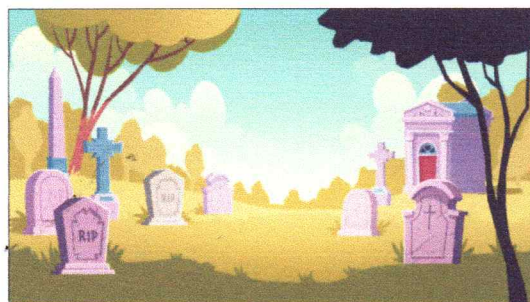
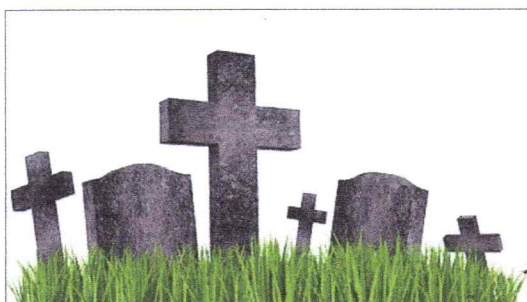

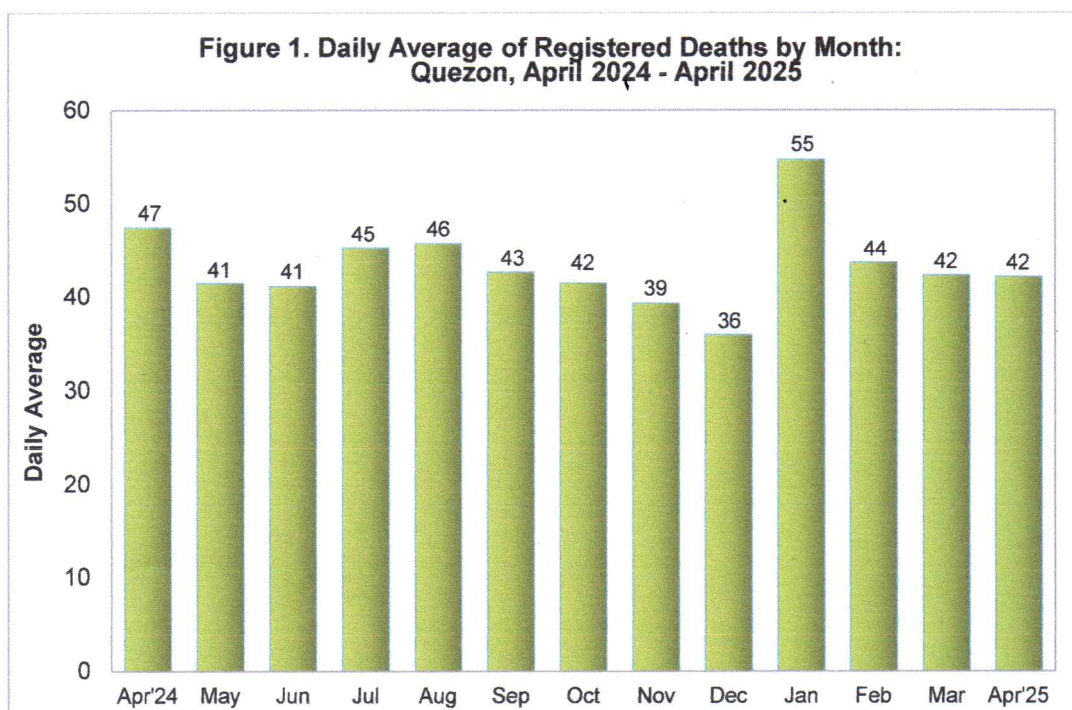
DEATH STATISTICS IN QUEZON: April 2025 (Preliminary Results)

Number of Deaths...

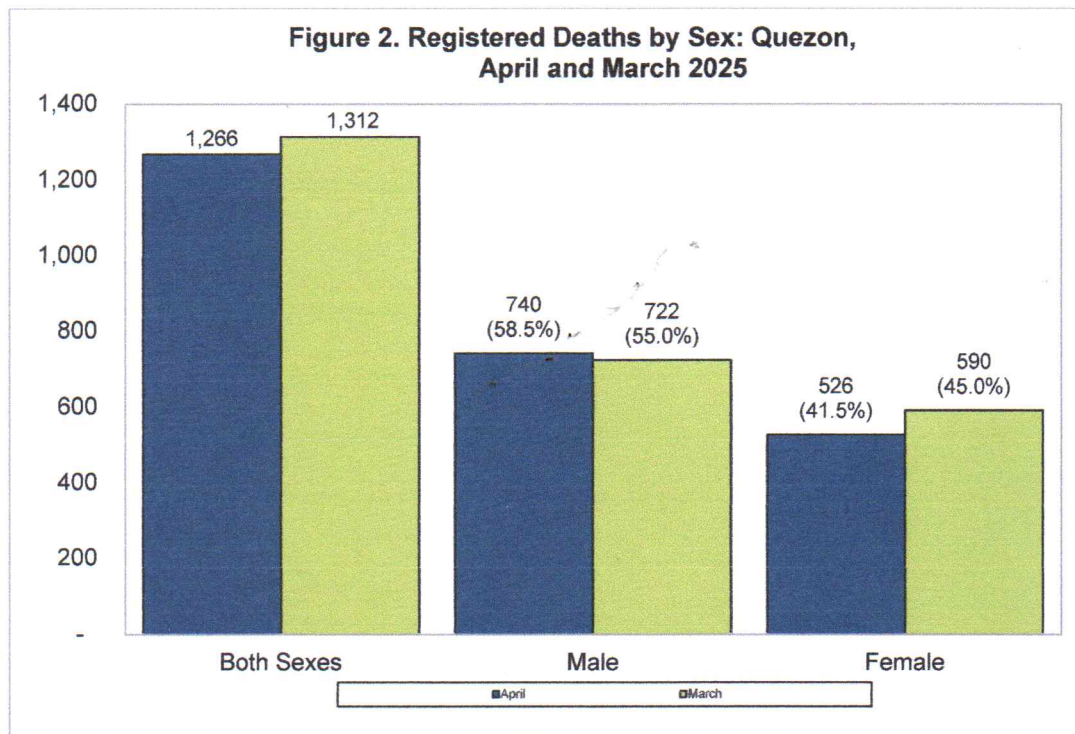
- There were 1,266 registered deaths in Quezon in April 2025. It recorded a decrease of 3.5 percent from the previous month's figure of 1,312.
- The daily average of death occurrences during the month was 42 or approximately two (2) deaths per hour.

Deaths by Sex...

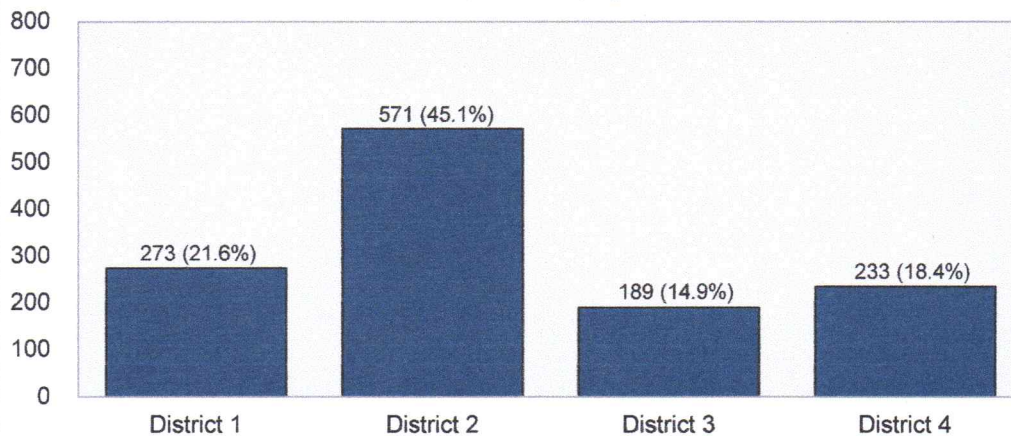
- There were more male deaths (740 or 58.5%) than female deaths (526 or 41.5%) registered during the month.
- The death sex ratio was calculated at 141 males for every 100 females in April 2025.



Deaths by Place of Occurrence and Usual Place of Residence...

- Lucena City recorded the most number of registered deaths at 364 or 28.8 percent. This may be explained by its large population and the health facilities available in the city.
- The municipalities of Candelaria and Sariaya had the second-highest number of registered deaths, each with 73 or 5.8%, followed by Infanta with 71 or 5.6%, and Lopez and City of Tayabas, both with 57 or 4.5%, respectively.
- There were 253 deaths that occurred outside the usual place of residence of the deceased.
- Lucena City recorded the highest number of deaths (187) that occurred outside the usual residence of the deceased. It was followed by Infanta (26) and Gumaca (17).
- Majority of the rest of the municipalities and city of the province registered higher number of deaths by usual residence than the number of deaths by place of occurrence.


**Figure 3. Registered Deaths by District:

TECHNICAL NOTES

Vital Registration is a continuous process. Hence, there is a need to specify certain cut-off period for purposes of reporting. The Death Statistics in Quezon presented in this report contains highlights and summary of statistical tables of deaths that occurred on or before April 2025 and registered within the said month. Events that occurred in April 2025 but were not registered during the month were not included in this publication. For this report, Vital Events Information (VEI) system was used in data encoding.
