BIRTH STATISTICS IN QUEZON: March 2025 (Preliminary Results)

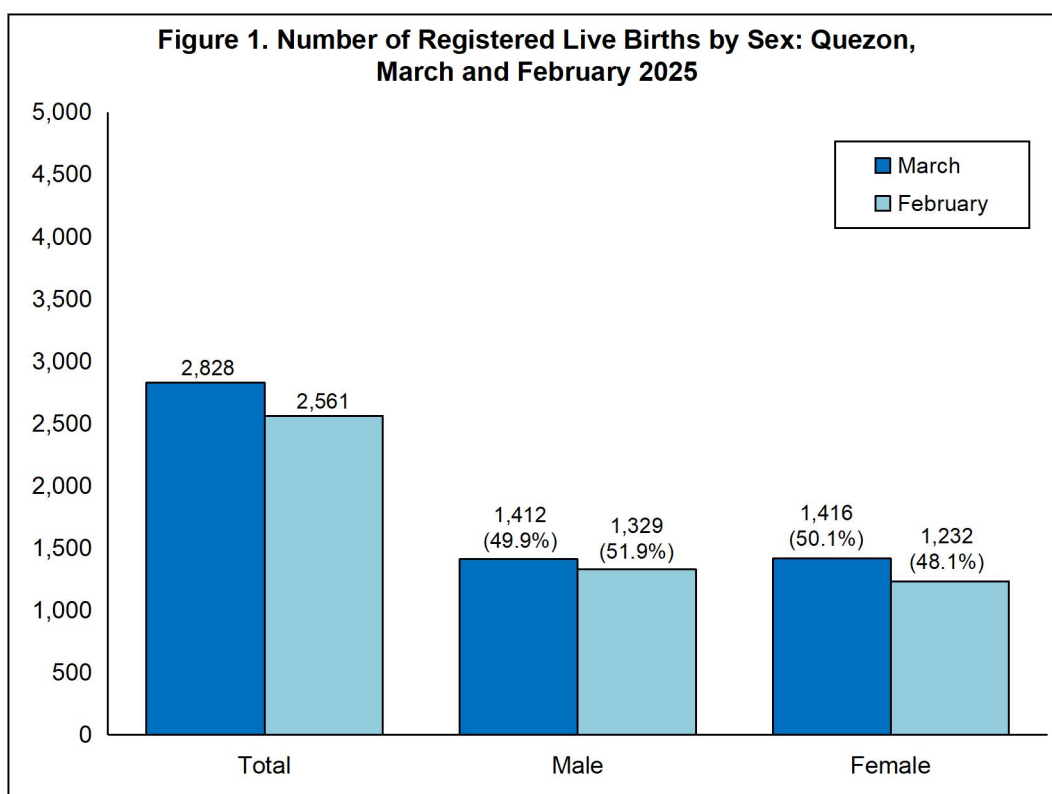

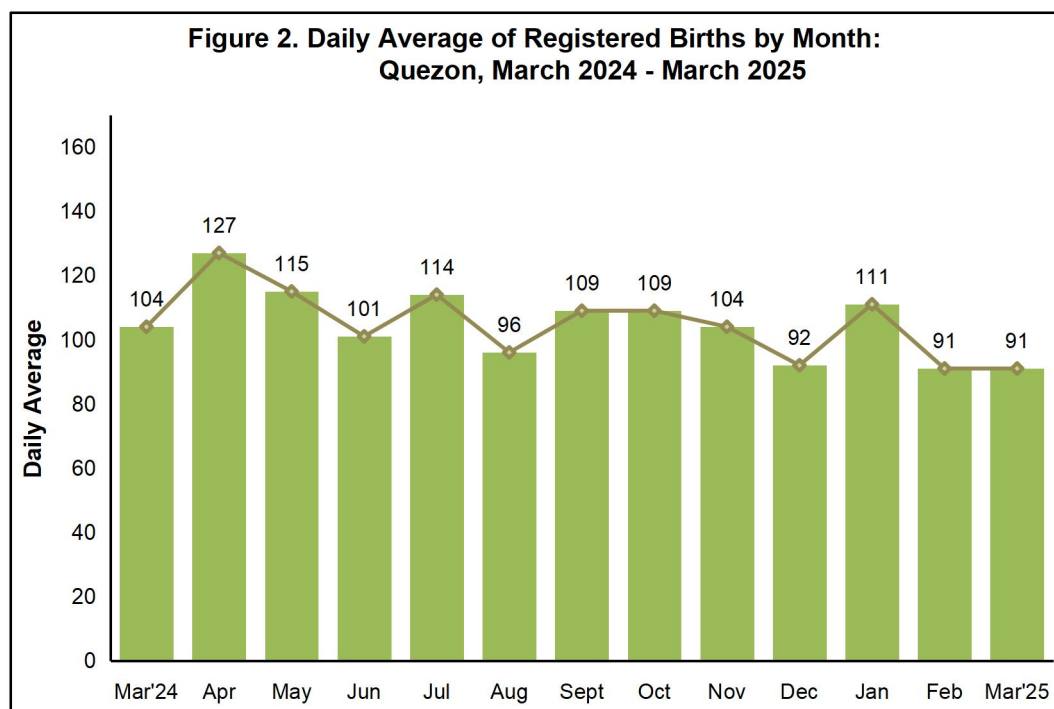


Number of Live births...

- A total of 2,828 live births were registered in the province in March 2025. It recorded an increase of 10.4 percent from the February 2025 figure of 2,561.
- Of the total births registered, 49.9 percent were males and 50.1 percent were females. This resulted to a birth sex ratio of 100 males for every 100 females.



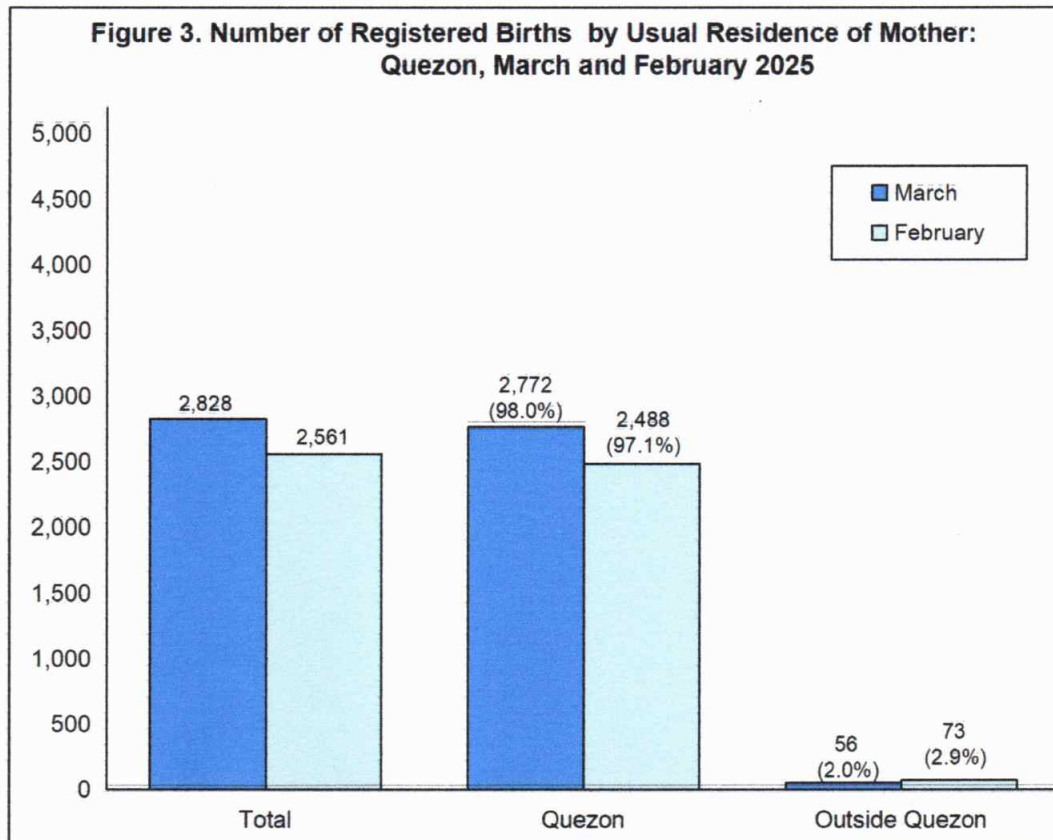
- An average of 91 births per day was observed during the month, identical to the daily average recorded in February 2025.
- Lucena City recorded the highest number of live births with a total of 770 or 27.2 percent of the total births registered in the province. It was followed by Lopez and Candelaria with 199 or 7.0 percent and 152 or 5.4 percent, respectively.
- The four (4) municipalities with the least number of registered births were Plaridel and Quezon (both with 1 or 0.4%) and Perez and Pitogo (both with 4 or 0.14%).



Place of Occurrence and Usual Residence of Mother...


- Majority of the registered births were born to mothers whose usual residence is in Quezon province (2,772 or 98.0%).
- Only a small percentage of the birth occurrences (56 or 2.0%) were born to mothers whose usual residence is outside Quezon province.
- Eleven (11) out of the 39 municipalities and 2 cities of Quezon province showed a positive difference in the number of births by place of occurrence and the usual place of residence of the mother. This implies that there were mothers who opted to give birth to places where there are available or better health care facilities and social services.
- The highest positive difference of 415 was reported in Lucena City. This may be attributed to higher number of hospitals and health care facilities located in the city.

- In contrast, the highest negative difference of 76 was observed in Sariaya. This may be explained by its proximity to Lucena City where there are more health care facilities.



TECHNICAL NOTES

Vital Registration is a continuous process. Hence there is a need to specify certain cut-off period for purposes of reporting. The Birth Statistics in Quezon presented in this report contains highlights and summary of statistical tables of births that occurred on or before March 2025 and registered within the said month. Events that occurred in March 2025 but were not registered during the month were not included in this publication. For this report, Vital Events Information (VEI) system was used in data encoding.
