BIRTH STATISTICS IN QUEZON: September 2023 (Preliminary Results)








Live births...

- A total of 4,335 live births were registered in the province in September 2023. It recorded an increase of 5.6 percent from the August 2023 figure of 4,106.
- ➤ Of the total births registered, 50.9 percent were males and 49.1 percent were females. This resulted to a birth sex ratio of 104 males for every 100 females.






- ➤ The daily average of birth occurrences during the month was 145, higher than the recorded daily average of 132 in August 2023.
- Lucena City recorded the highest number of live births with a total of 1,006 or 23.2 percent of the total births registered in the province. It was followed by Lopez and Candelaria with 373 or 8.6 percent and 301 or 6.9 percent, respectively.
- ➤ The top five (5) municipalities with the least number of registered births were Sampaloc and Agdangan (both with 7 or 0.16%), Perez and Quezon (both with 6 or 0.14%), and Plaridel (4 or 0.09%).


Attendant at Birth...

- ➤ The 2,983 (68.8%) birth deliveries were attended to by medically trained personnel such as physicians, nurses and midwives.
- ➤ Among the medically trained personnel, physicians attended to the most number of deliveries with 1,882 or 43.4 percent of the total births registered.
- ➤ The number of birth occurrences delivered by the traditional birth attendants and those without medical training was 1,352 or 31.2 percent of the total.
- ➤ By residence of mother, five municipalities in the province recorded higher number of live births attended to by traditional birth attendants compared to those attended to by health professionals. These were the municipalities of San Francisco (89.5%), Patnanungan (88.2%), Burdeos (73.0%), Panukulan (70.4%), and San Narciso (64.6%).




Age-group of mother...

- Seven (7) in ten (10) births were born to mothers aged 20-34 (2,989 or 69.0%).
- > The number of births born to teenage mothers was 563 or 13.0 percent.
- > A total of 29 births or 0.7 percent were born to mothers at the menopausal age (45 years old and over).




Place of Occurrence and Usual Residence of Mother...

- ➤ Majority of the registered births were born to mothers whose usual residence is in Quezon province (4,278 or 98.7%).
- ➤ Only a small percentage of the birth occurrences (57 or 1.3%) were born to mothers whose usual residence is outside Quezon province.
- ➤ Eight (8) out of the 39 municipalities and 2 cities of Quezon province showed a positive difference in the number of births by place of occurrence and the usual place of residence of the mother. This implies that there were mothers who opted to give birth to places where there are available or better health care facilities and social services.
- ➤ The highest positive difference of 509 was reported in Lucena City. This may be attributed to higher number of hospitals and health care facilities located in the city.
- ➤ In contrast, the highest negative difference of 103 was observed in Sariaya. This may be explained by its proximity to Lucena City.




Legitimacy Status...

➤ More than half of the total births registered during the month (3,057 or 70.5%) were born illegitimate.



- ➤ Teenage mothers recorded the highest percentage (95.7%) of babies born out of wedlock.
- ➤ All municipalities and cities of Quezon registered high percentages of births with illegitimate status.
- ➤ The highest number of registered live births with illegitimate status was born to mothers aged 20-24 years old (900 or 29.4%) followed by those born to mothers aged 25-29 (720 or 23.6%).
- ➤ Generally, the percentage of babies born illegitimate is inversely proportional to the age group of mothers. The higher the percentage of babies born illegitimate, the younger the age group to which the mothers belong.



TECHNICAL NOTES

Vital Registration is a continuous process. Hence there is a need to specify certain cut-off period for purposes of reporting. The Birth Statistics in Quezon presented in this report contains highlights and summary of statistical tables of births that occurred on or before September 2023 and registered within the said month. Events that occurred in September 2023 but were not registered during the month were not included in this publication. For this report, Decentralized Vital Statistics System (DVSS) 2011 was used in data encoding. In the generation of DVSS tables however, CSPro 7.1 was utilized.
