

SPECIAL RELEASE

DVSS MARCH 2025 (BIRTH, MARRIAGE, AND DEATH STATISTICS)

Date of Release: 30 May 2025

Reference No. 2025-005

This report summarizes the administrative data gathered from the documents submitted last March 2025 by the thirteen (13) Municipal Civil Registry Offices and one (1) City Civil Registry Office in the Province of Rizal.

The province generated the following statistics: three thousand three hundred seventy-six (3,376) for birth, eight hundred ninety (890) for marriage, and one thousand three hundred twenty-seven (1,327) for death.

Civil registration is a continuous, permanent, and compulsory recording of vital events occurring in the life of an individual such as birth, marriage, and death as well as court decrees, and legal instruments affecting his civil status in appropriate registers as mandated by Act No. 3753, the Civil Registry Law.

In this March 2025 issue, the Philippine Statistics Authority of Rizal presents the number of births, marriages, and deaths registered by the city and municipalities in the province. The data

province are preliminary results from the Decentralized Vital Statistics System 2011 based on the documents submitted (Timely and Late Registered) by the Local Civil Registry Offices in Rizal.

Live Birth is a complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of a product of conception, irrespective of the duration of the pregnancy, which after such separation, breathes or shows any other evidence of life, such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles, whether or not the umbilical cord has been cut or the placenta is attached-each product of such a birth is considered live born.

The Province of Rizal recorded 3,376 registered live births for the month of March 2025. This represents 7.24 percent increase based on the 3,148 registered live births from the previous month, i.e., February 2025.

The City of Antipolo had the highest contribution of live births in the province of Rizal as of March 2025 with 1,084 registrations, followed by Rodriguez with 484 registrations, and Taytay with 359 registrations, while the Municipality of Jalajala had the least contribution, with only 15-recorded live births.

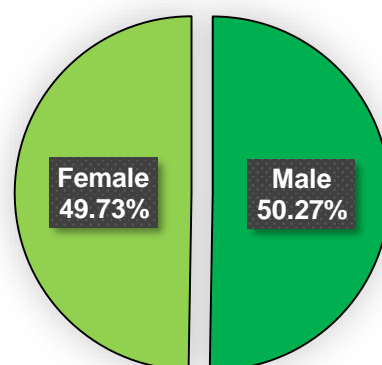
There were around 109 newborn babies daily in the province for the month of March 2025.

As seen in Figure 1, 50.27 percent of the newborn babies were male, and 49.73 percent were females. This means that there were slightly more male born babies than female born babies, with 1.07 percent difference for the month of March 2025 in the Province of Rizal.



MARRIAGE STATISTICS

Marriage is a special contract of permanent union between a man and a woman entered in accordance with law for the establishment of conjugal and family life.

As Table C shows, there were 890 registered marriages for the month of March 2025 in the Province of Rizal, this is higher compared from the 778 registered marriages during the previous month. This implies that there was a 14.40 percent increase in the number of registered marriages in the Province of Rizal from February 2025 to March 2025.

The city/municipality that accounted for the highest number of registered marriages was the City of Antipolo with 306 registered marriages, followed by Taytay with 150 documents, and Rodriguez with 101 registered marriages.



In Rizal, there were 16 Filipinas married to foreign nationals (i.e., four (4) Americans, one (1) Chinese, two (2) Japanese and nine (9) other nationalities.)



DEATH STATISTICS

Death refers to the permanent disappearance of all evidence of life at any time after live birth has taken place (post-natal cessation of vital function without capability of resuscitation).

The Province of Rizal recorded one thousand three hundred twenty-seven (1,327) for the month of March 2025.

Table D shows that for the month of March 2025, there were 1,227 registered deaths that were residents of the province and 100 were nonresident citizens with a total of 1,327 registration of deaths, compared to the 1,247 total recorded deaths of the previous month (i.e., February 2025). This suggests a increase 6.42 percent in the number of registration of deaths in the Province

of Rizal from February 2025 to March 2025.



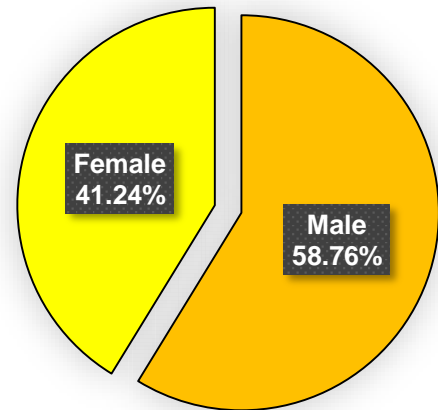
The City of Antipolo accounted for the highest number of recorded deaths of residents in the Province of Rizal for the month of March 2025 with 295 registered deaths, which with a huge gap is followed by Binangonan with 152 registered deaths, and Cainta with 140 registered deaths for the month of March 2025.



There were 19 fetal death records in the Province of Rizal for the month of March 2025, higher compared to 14 fetal death records of February 2025.

Figure II. Registered Deaths of Residents by Sex and by City/Municipality Rizal: March 2025

For the month of March 2025, males, who were residents of Rizal, had a higher number of registered deaths, accounting for 58.76 percent compared to the 41.24 percent registered deaths of female residents. (See Figure II).




