

The headline inflation in Laguna increase to 2.6 percent in February 2024 from 1.6 percent in January 2024. Moreover, this is lower than the recorded inflation rate in the same month of February 2023 at 5.9 percent. The average inflation rate for the year 2024 stood at 2.1 percent. (Table A and Figure 1)

The increase of province's inflation was primarily due to the higher annual increment recorded in the indices of Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages at 2.9 percent in February 2024 from 1.8 percent in January 2024; Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels at 2.6 percent from 2.3 percent; Health at 2.9 percent from 1.5 percent; Transport at 2.6 percent from 1.1 percent; Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco at 7.7 percent from 6.1 percent; Clothing and Footwear at 2.4 percent from 1.5 percent; Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance at 2.7 percent from 1.7 percent; Information and Communication at 0.2 percent from 0.0 percent; Recreation, Sport and Culture at 2.7 percent from 2.1 percent; Restaurants and Accommodation Services at 1.4 percent from 0.4 percent; and Personal Care, and Miscellaneous Goods and Services at 3.5 percent from 2.1 percent.

The rest of the commodity groups retained their previous month's inflation rates. (Table B)

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The increase in inflation for Food Indices was mainly brought by Meat and Other Slaughtered Land Animals at -1.7 percent in February 2024 from -3.5 percent in January 2024; Rice at 20.9 percent from 19.5 percent; Flour, Bread and Other Bakery Products, Pasta Products, and Other Cereals at 4.9 percent from 4.6 percent; Vegetables, Tubers, Cooking Bananas and Pulses at -7.3 percent from -19.2 percent; Ready-Made Food and Other Food Products N.E.C at 3.6 percent from 3.4 percent; Sugar, Confectionery and Desserts at 1.7 percent from 1.4 percent; Oils and Fats at 1.5 percent from 0.1 percent; and Corn at 5.8 percent from -3.1 percent.

Meanwhile, slowdown in inflation was observed in Fish and Other Seafood at -0.7 percent in February 2024 from 2.6 percent in January 2024; Milk and Other Dairy Products and Eggs at 0.3 percent from 2.7 percent; and Fruits and Nuts at 2.5 percent from 3.6 percent; (Table C)

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
